Changes to LCAP in Response to COVID-19

Given the uncertainties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the impact California's response has had on a local educational agency's (LEA's) ability to meaningfully engage with stakeholders, Executive Order N-56-20 was established.



Executive Order N-56-20

- Extends the deadline for adoption of the 2020–21 LCAP from July 1, 2020, to December 15, 2020
- Delays implementation of the three-year LCAP template adopted by the State Board of Education (SBE) until the 2021–22 through 2023–24 school years
- Waives certain LCAP related budgetary requirements, including:
 - Adopting an LCAP prior to adopting the 2020–21 budget
 - LCAP expenditures necessary to implement actions in an LCAP in the 2020–21 budget
- Establishes a requirement to provide a **written report to the community** that explains the changes to program offerings that the LEA has made in response to school closures to address the COVID-19 emergency and the major impacts of such closures on students and families



COVID-19 Written Report to the Community

The *COVID-19 Operations Written Report* to the community must include a description of how the LEA is meeting the needs of unduplicated pupils (low income, English learner, foster youth) during the period of school closures and the steps taken by the LEA to support the following:

- Continue delivering high-quality distance learning opportunities;
- Provide school meals in non-congregate settings; and
- Arrange for supervision of students during ordinary school hours



COVID-19 Operations Written Report

- The COVID-19 Operations Written Report must be adopted by the local governing board with the LEA's budget, which is due on or before July 1, 2020
- A public hearing for the Written Report is not required
- An LEA must submit its adopted COVID-19 Operations Written Report to the appropriate budget approving entity, in conjunction with the submission of the adopted annual budget
- The adopted COVID-19 Operations Written Report must be posted on the LEA's website



2020-21 LCAP Process and Template

- The 2020-21 LCAP must be adopted by the local governing board on or before December 15, 2020
- County Superintendent of Schools' approval of the 2020-21 LCAP is due by January 14, 2021
- The precise template, metrics, and stakeholder process to be used for the 2020-21 LCAP is still to be determined and will be detailed in future legislation
- The CDE will be consulting with stakeholders and the State Board of Education (SBE) staff to develop the 2020-21 LCAP template and stakeholder process
- The 2020-21 LCAP template is anticipated to be finalized and posted by late summer 2020

December 15, 2020	2020-21 One-Year LCAP (<i>template to be determined</i>)
January 14, 2021	County Office Approval of 2020-21 One-Year LCAP
July 1, 2021	2021-24 Three-Year LCAP (<i>previously adopted template</i>)
