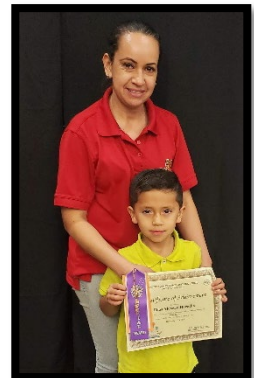
ATTEND TO ACHIEVE CELEBRATION

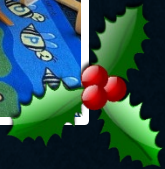
Kwis Elementary Spark of Love Event

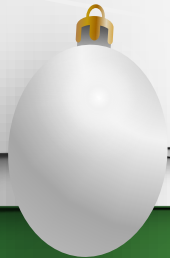
