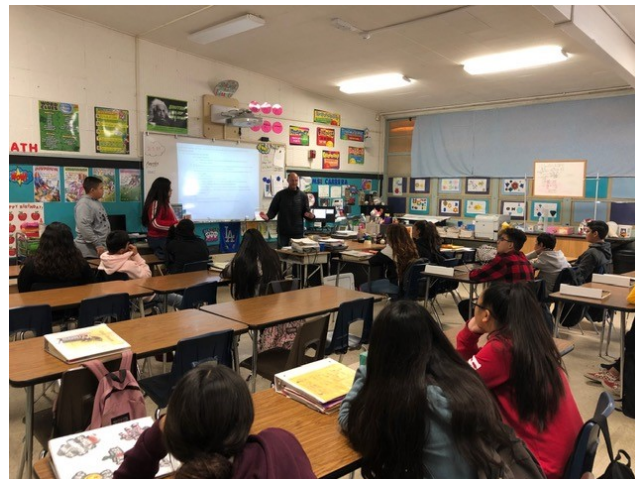
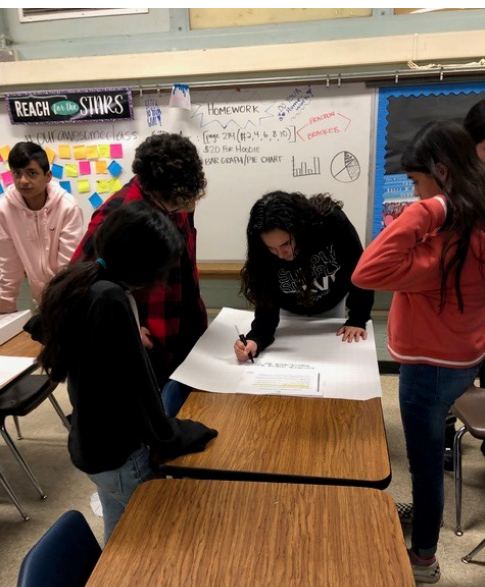
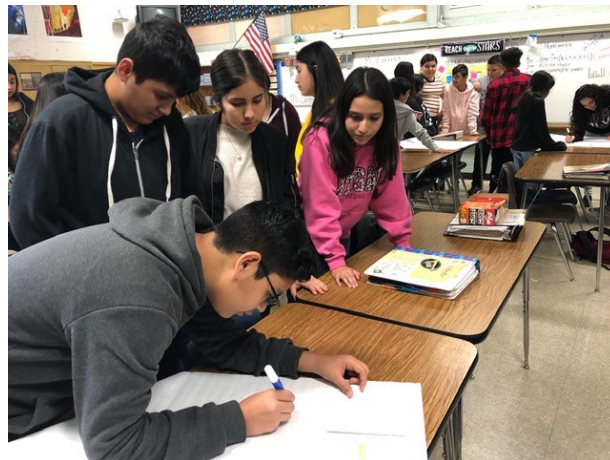
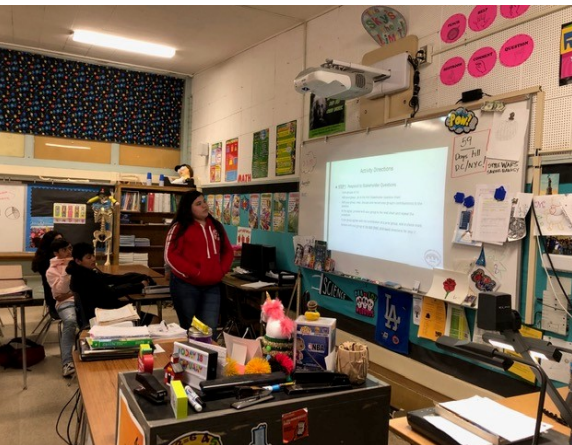
Student LCAP Advisory Committee

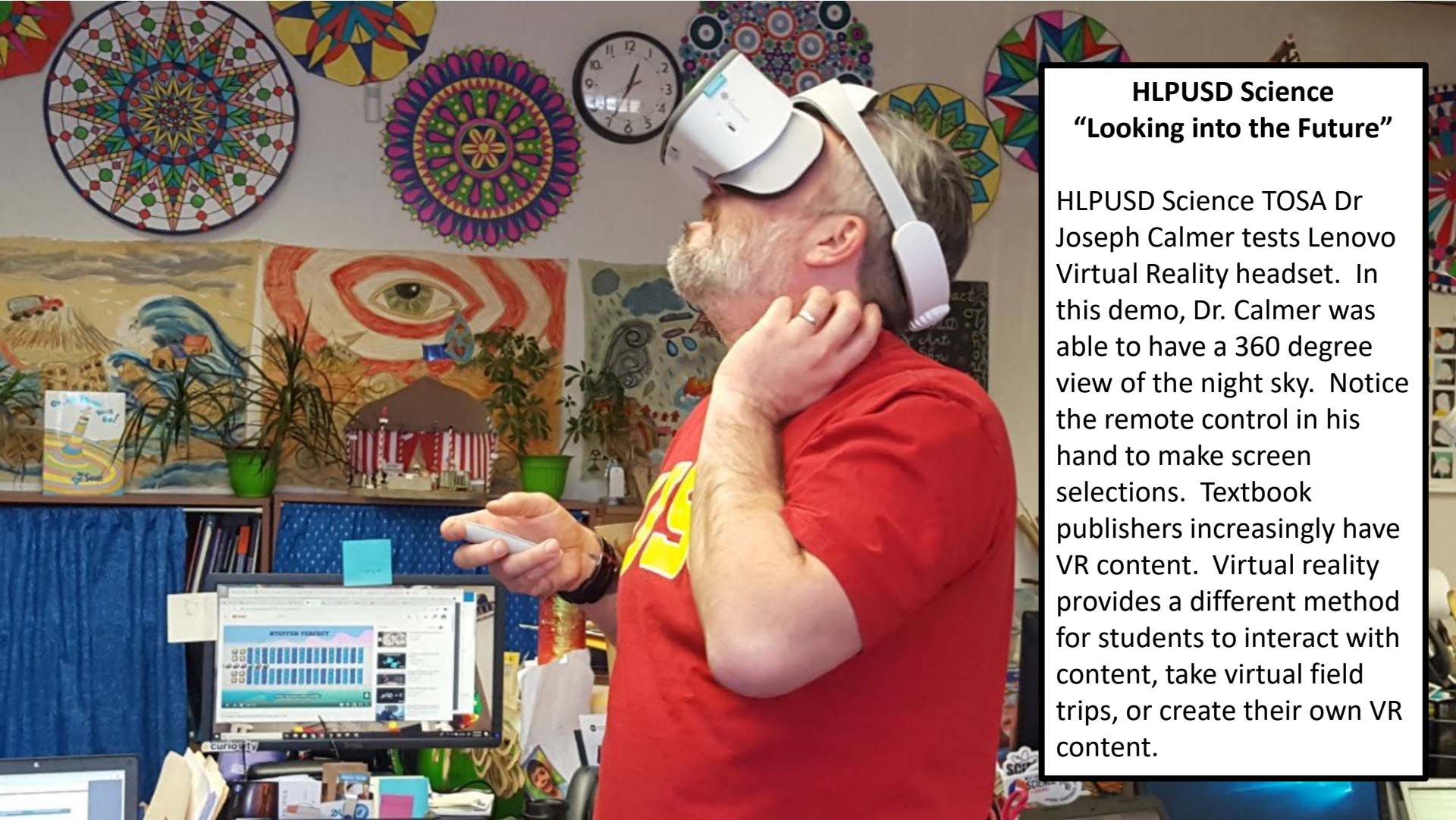




Adult Education Celebrates LVN & CNA Graduates!

CyberPatriot is the National Youth Cyber Education Program created by the Air Force Association (AFA) to inspire students toward careers in cybersecurity or other science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines critical to our nation's future. At the center of CyberPatriot is the National Youth Cyber Defense Competition. In the rounds of competition, teams are given a set of virtual images that represent operating systems and are tasked with finding cybersecurity vulnerabilities within the images and hardening the system while maintaining critical services in a six hour period. **Cedarlane Academy's two middle school teams advanced all the way to the national semi-finals on 2/2/2019. Our 7th grade team won 9th place, and our 8th grade team won 14th place out of 320 teams. Congratulations to the Cedarlane Thunderbirds!**

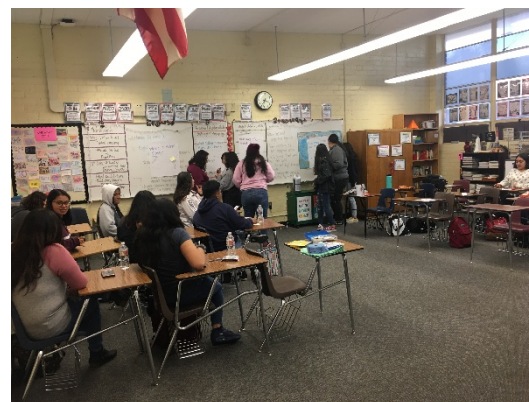
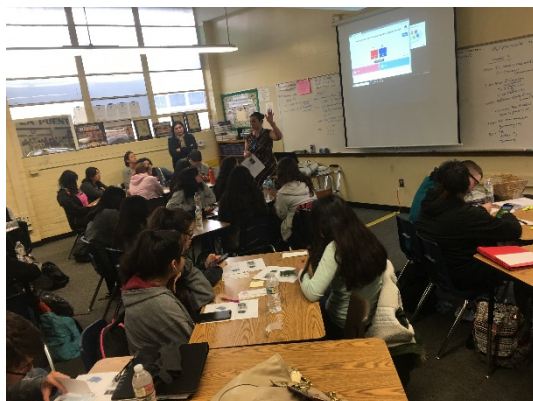


Teen Workshop Series
