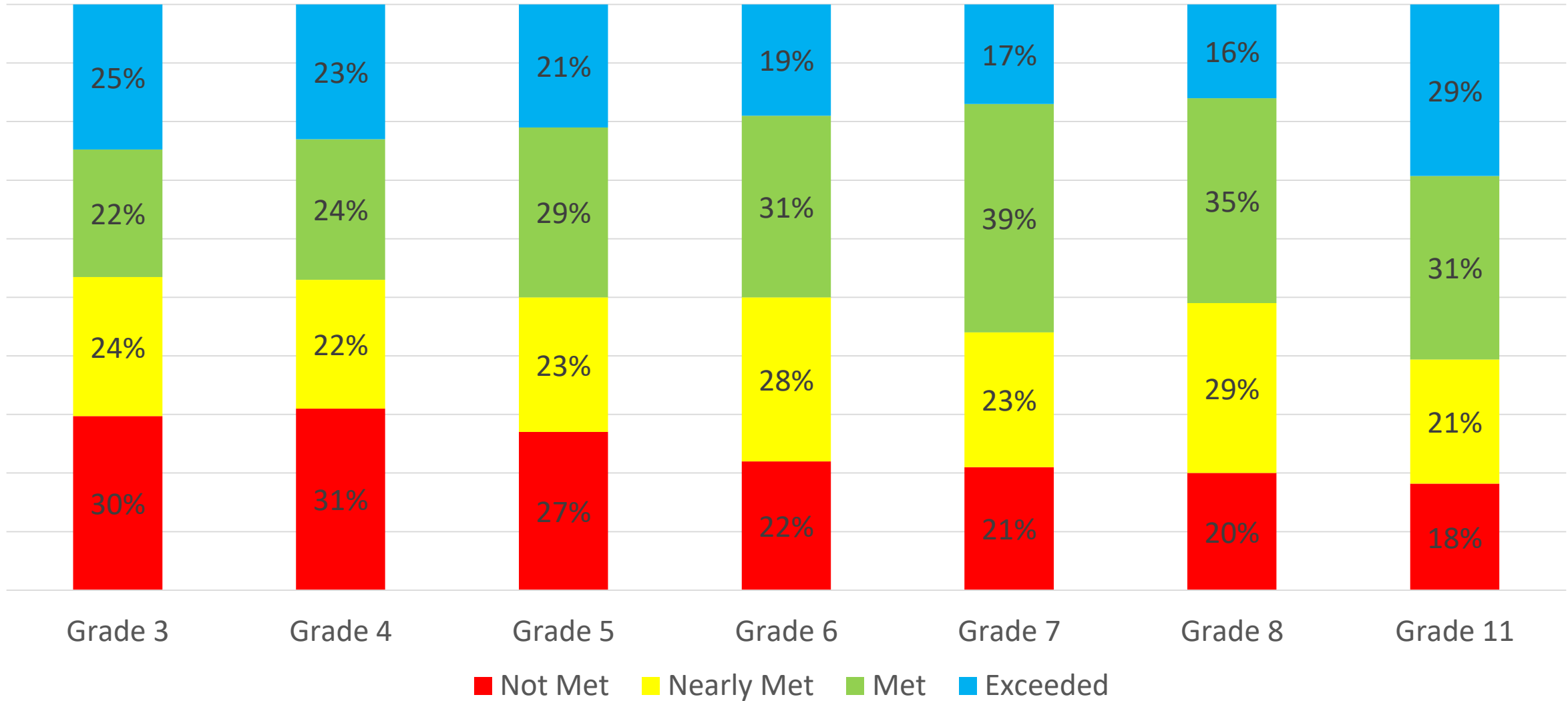

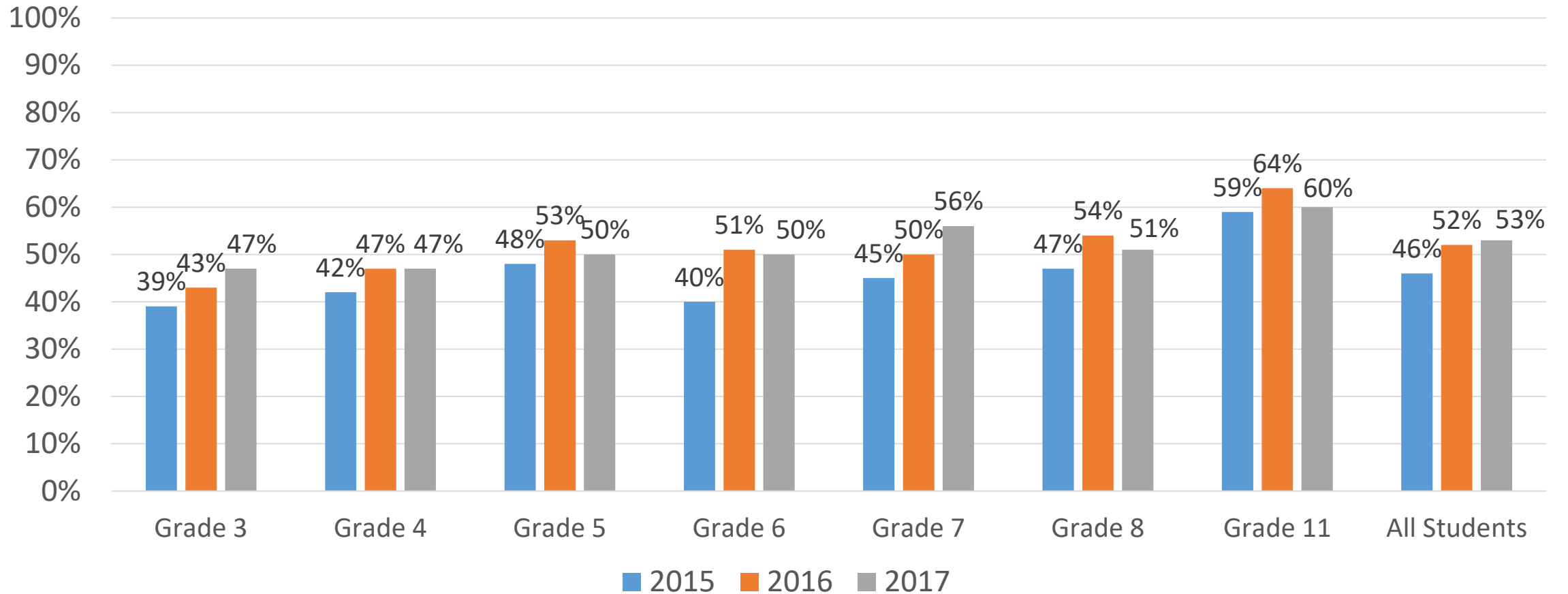

Student Score Distribution by Grade



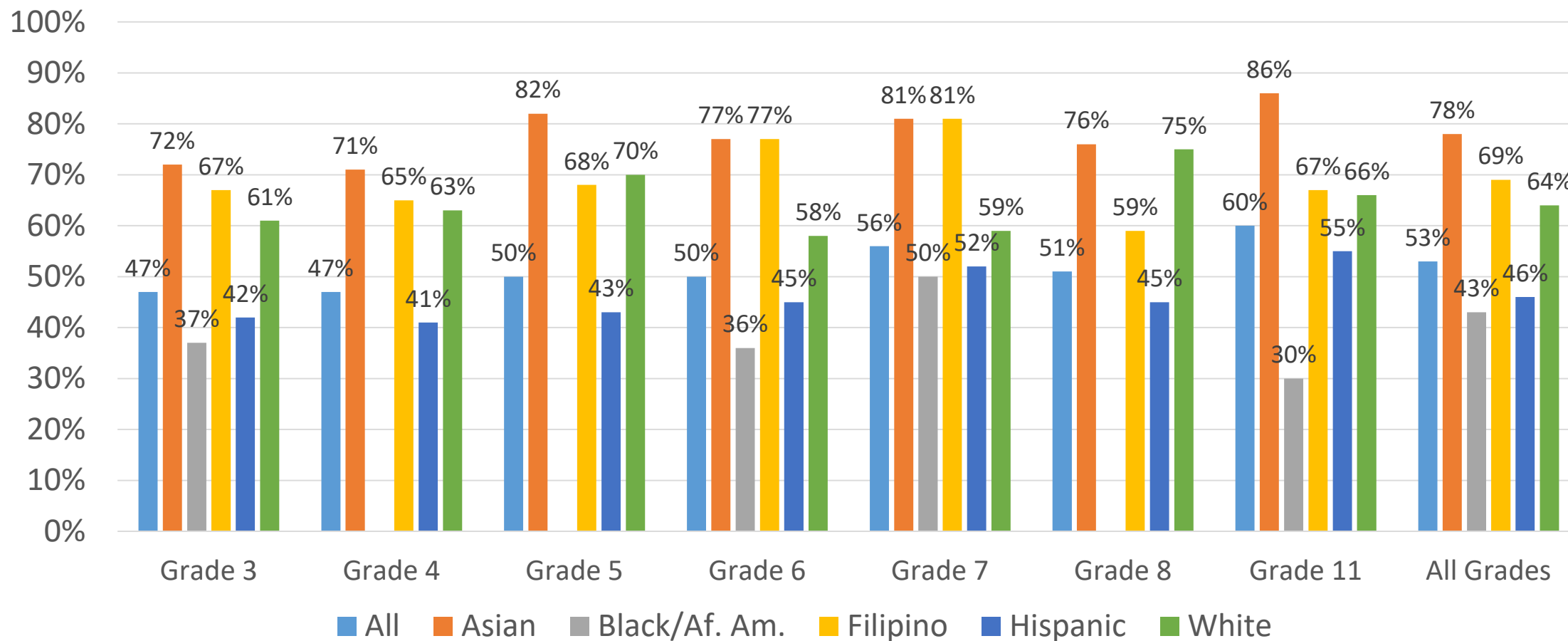

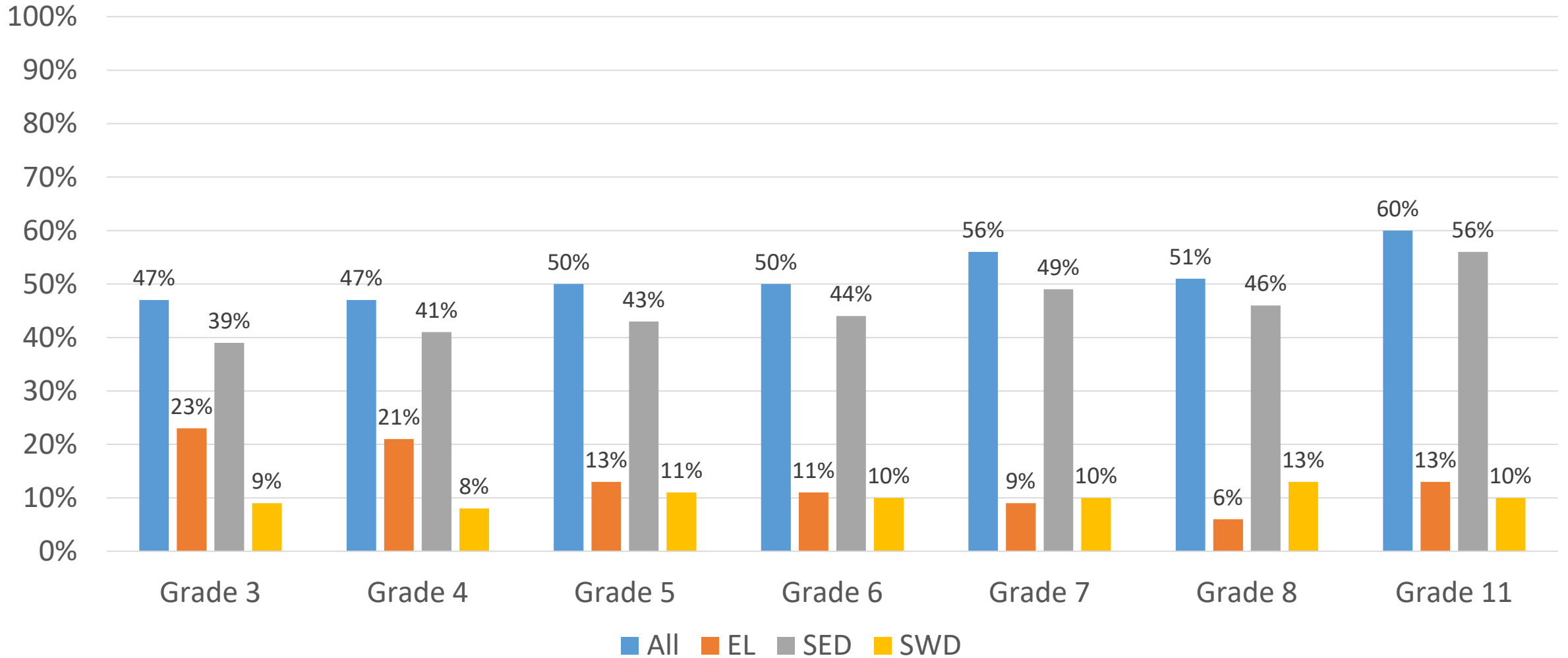

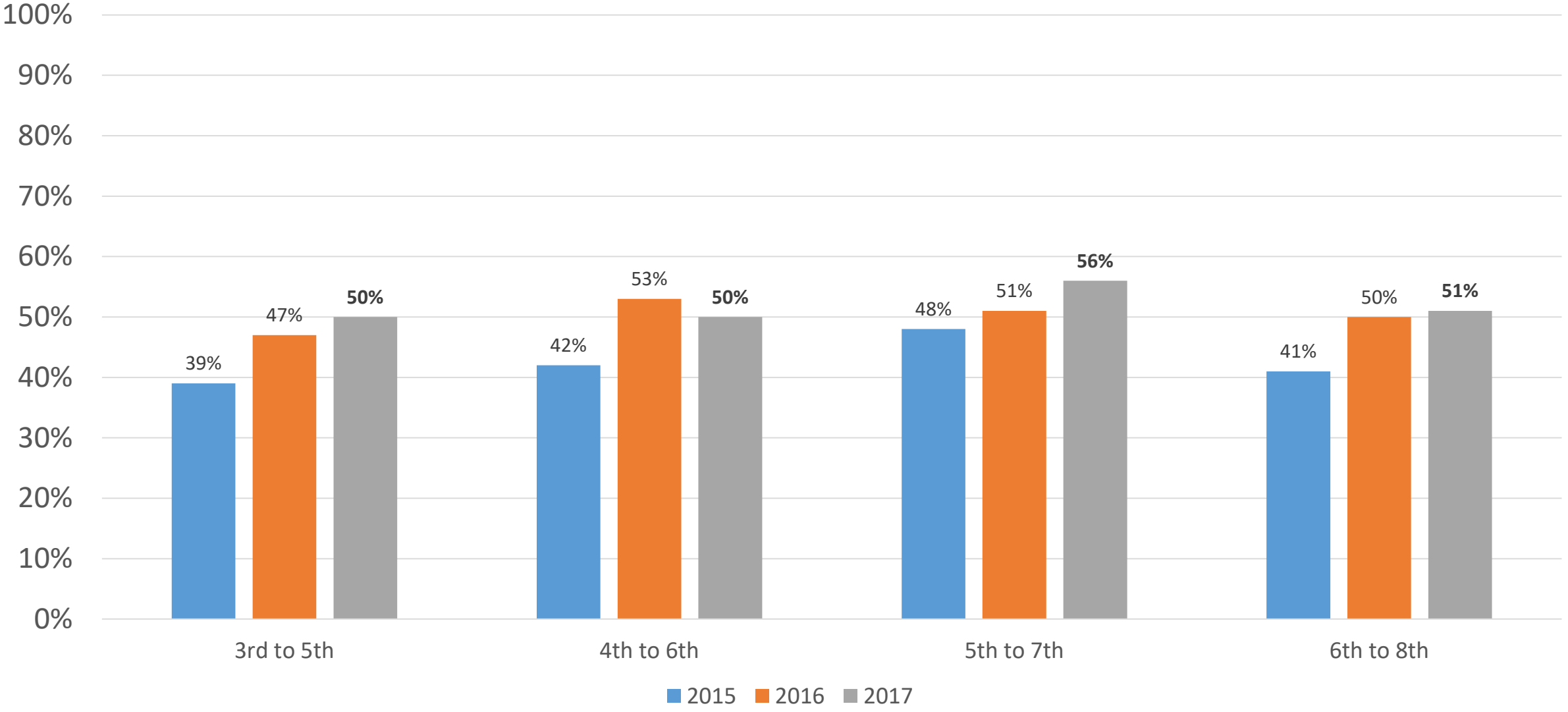

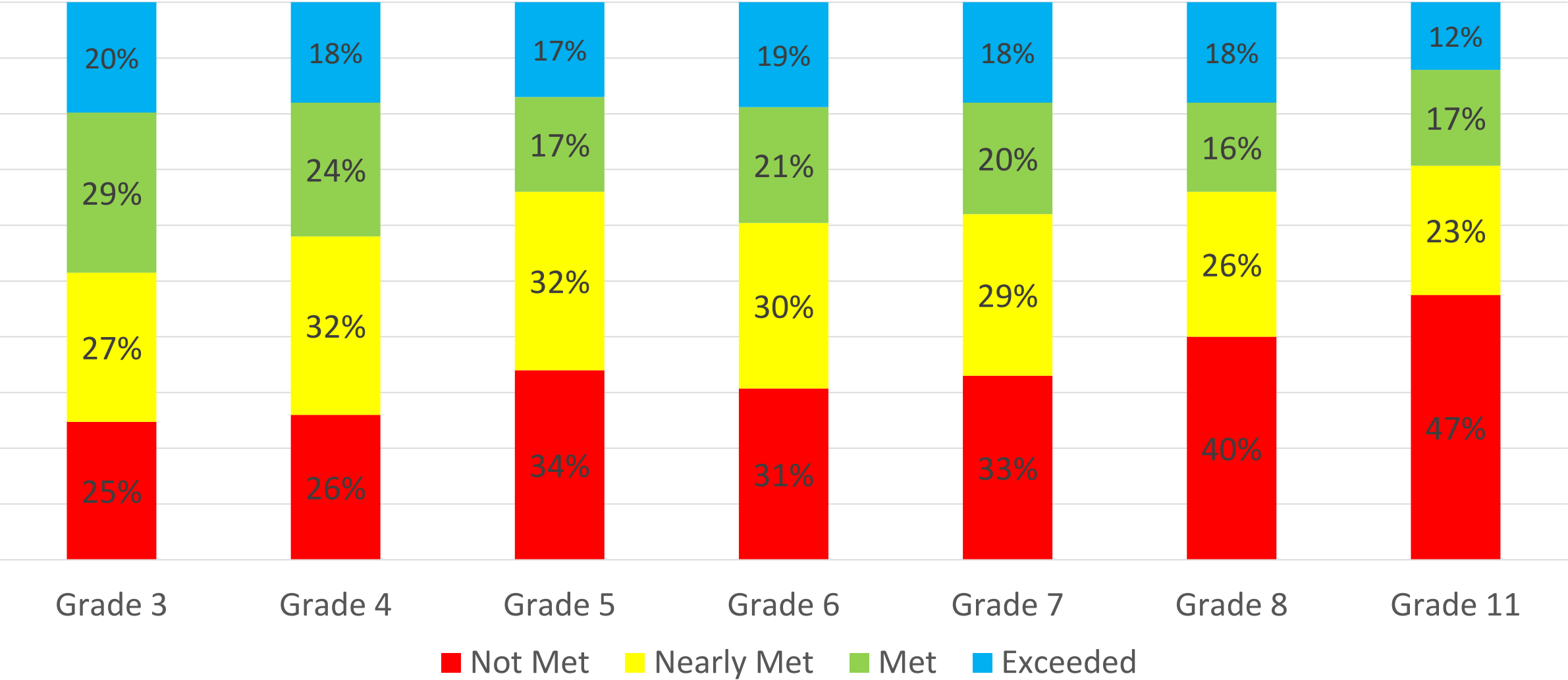

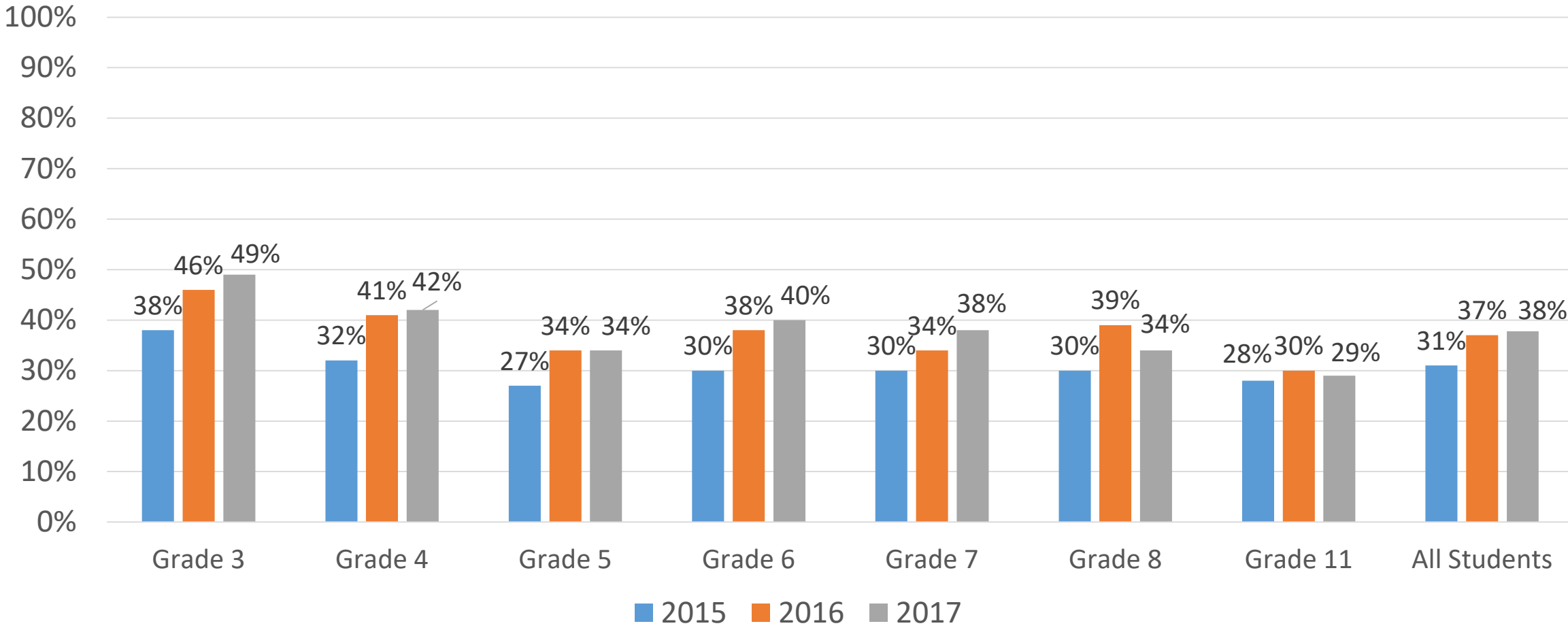

Student Score Distribution by Grade

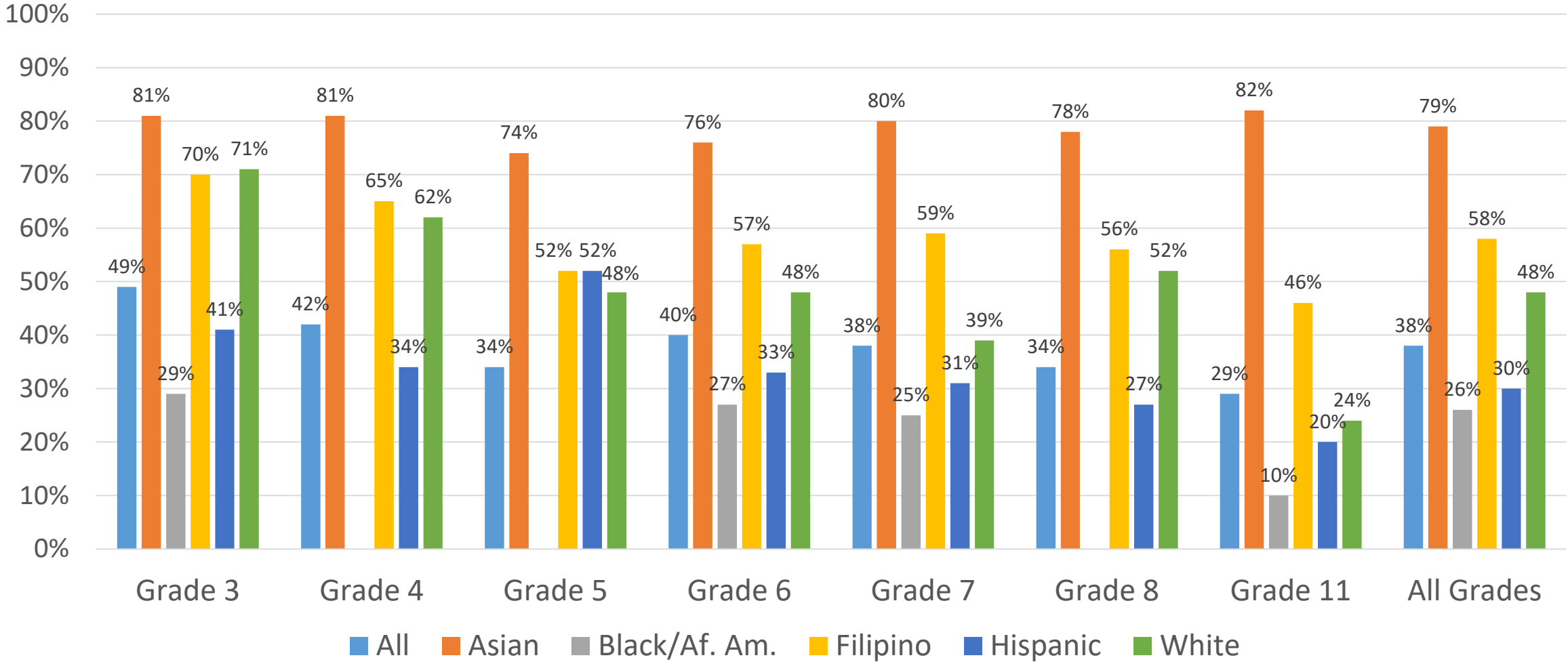




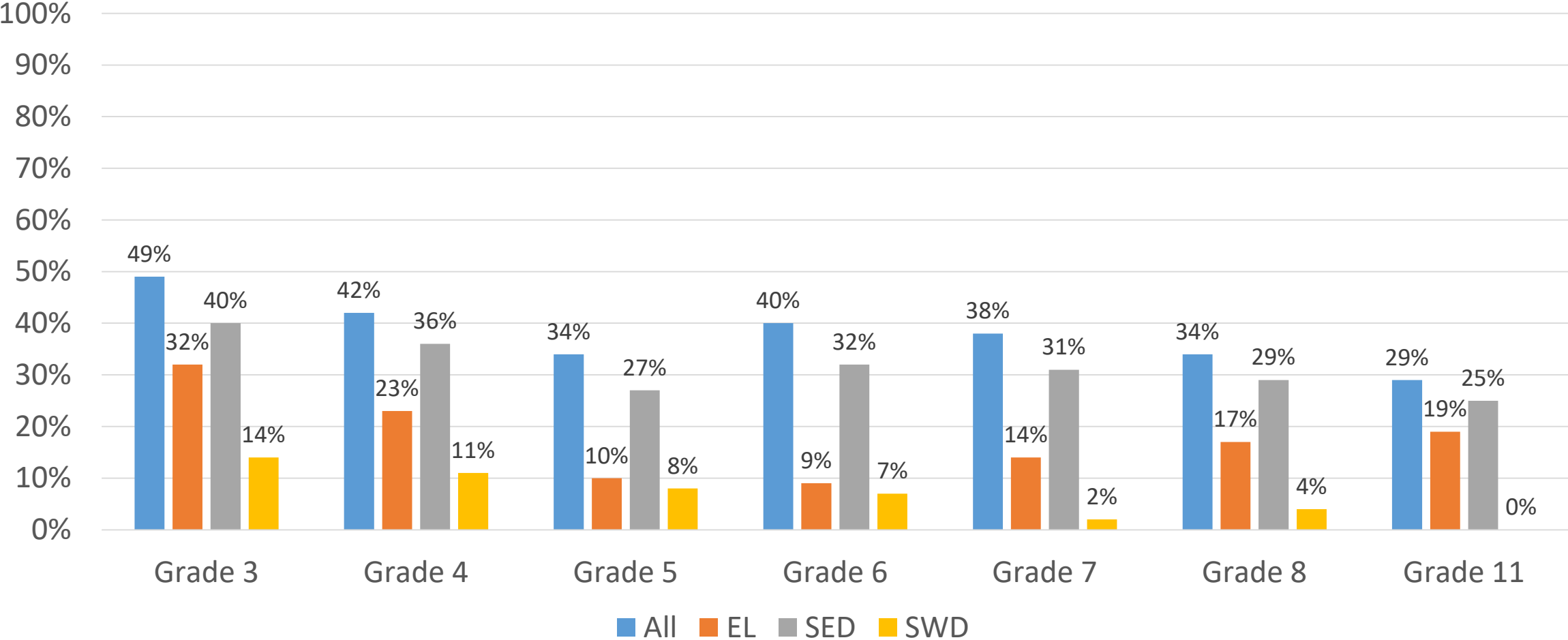

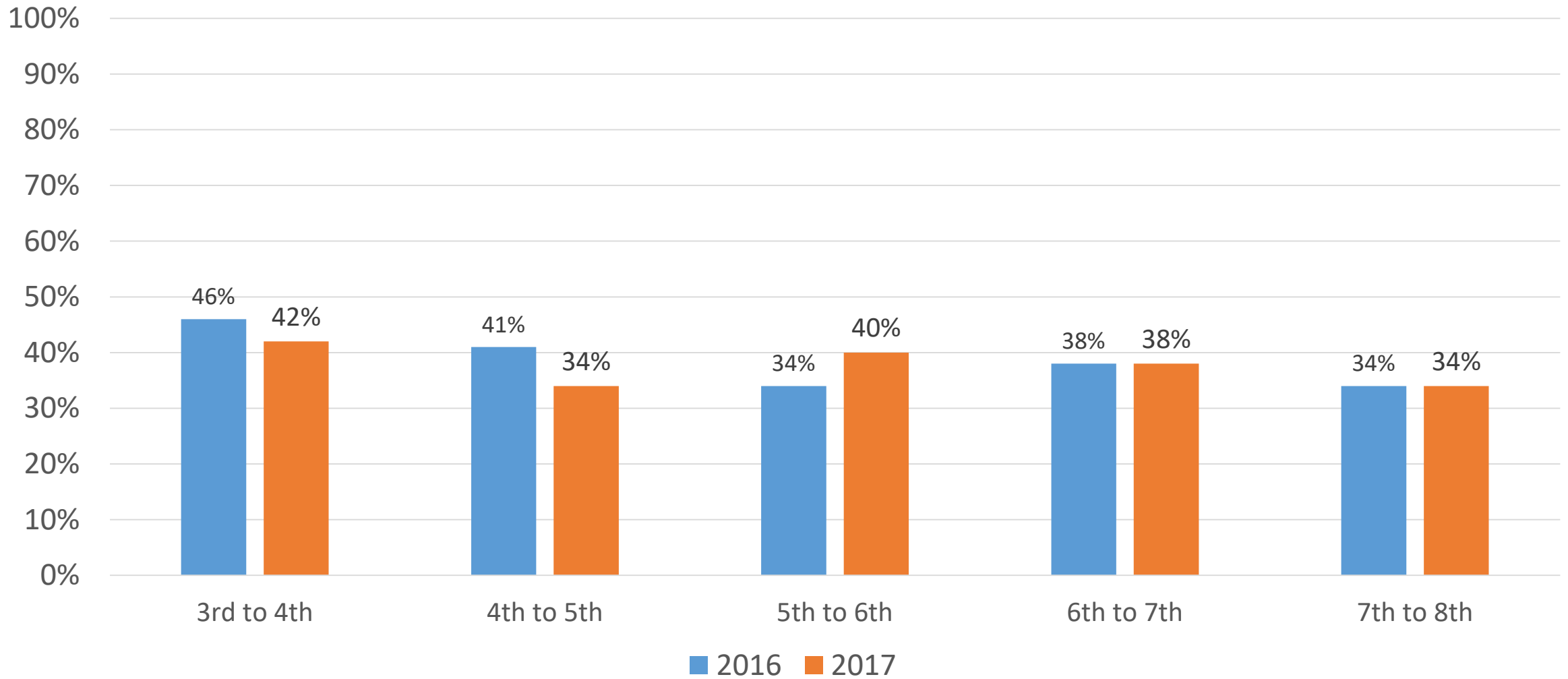

Students Meeting or Exceeding Standard By Significant Ethnic and Special Populations

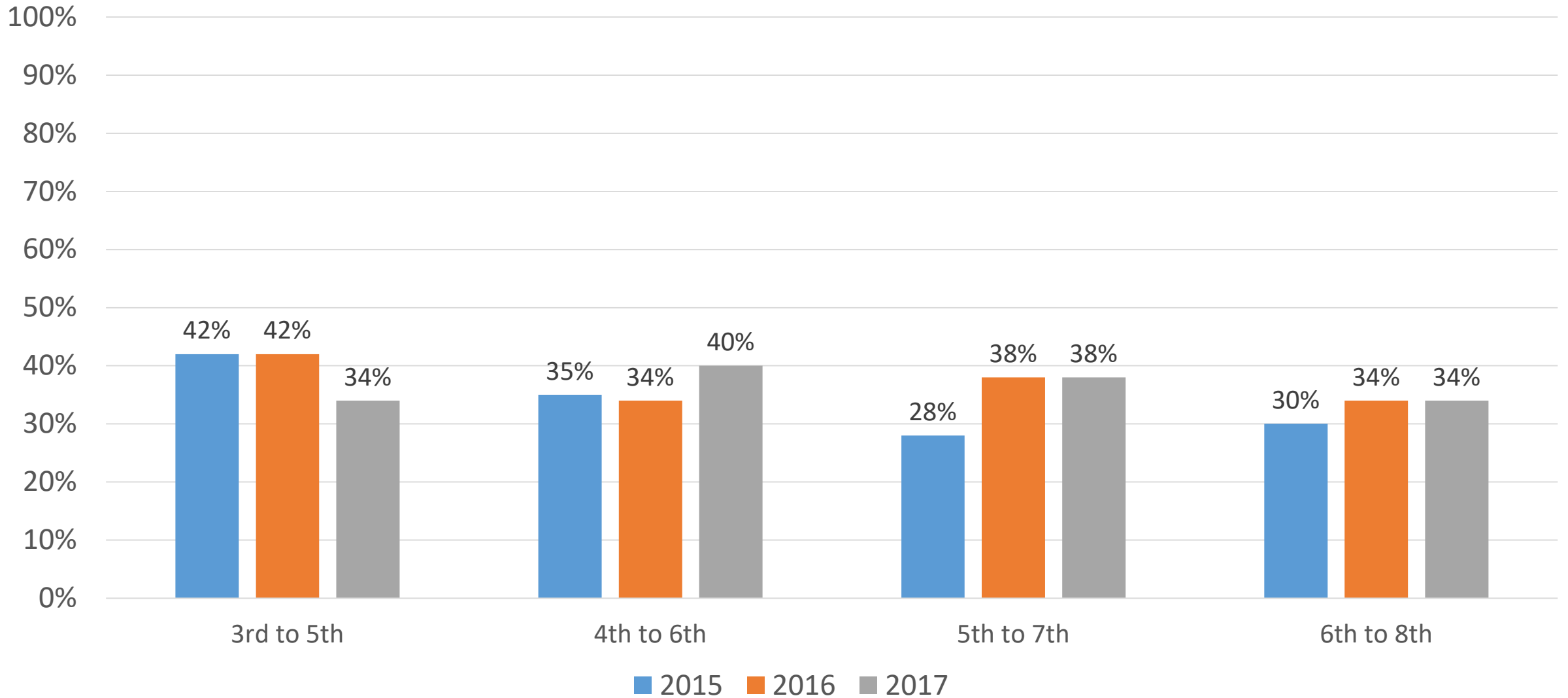

Observations



- 7% ELA and Math gains districtwide reflect the concentrated efforts of classroom teachers and students to provide a sound instructional program
- HLPUSD performed the same or better than state and county averages in both ELA and Math
- High priority groups demonstrated gains in both ELA and Math
- Teachers, administrators, and students are successfully transitioning to the Common Core Standards for ELA and Mathematics
- District remains focused on closing the achievement gap
- CAASPP is only one indicator of student progress and performance

Academic Achievement Plan



- **Continue focus on the District's 7 Instructional Goals**
- **Administrators & teachers identify priority areas for district and site PD**
- **Schools analyze data, set goals, and request PD to support priorities in/for**
 - Math instructional strategies
 - ELA instructional strategies
 - Science/NGSS Strategies
 - English Learners/Long Term English Learners
 - Students with Disabilities
 - Foster/Homeless Youth
 - Socio-economically Disadvantaged
- **PD continues for ELA and Math curriculum and instruction**
 - DNA Mathematics PD continues with the 80 Experts and a request from the teachers for Summer Math Academy IV
 - ELA & ELD PD continues in release time, after-school, and push-in
 - Curriculum Committees for elementary, middle and high schools review data, development interim assessments, design curriculum, and share best practices
- **PD for teachers and administrators on NGSS California Science Test (CAST) assessment**
 - Field test for 2018 – no data reported for schools or district
- **Technology** embedded instruction continues to develop in TK-12
- **Monitor progress via site-based data, Interim Assessments, and CAASPP**
