Some districts, like Santa Ana Unified and Hawthorne School District, have found ways to track how much they are spending to support each LCAP goal. Districts like Oakland Unified and Hacienda La Puente Unified have taken it one step further: they make all their accounting data available to the public through their websites.⁴ In these districts, both district and community stakeholders have a better understanding of how dollars are being spent and how they support district goals.
