## Obtaining a Student's State Student ID (SSID) using Aeries Parent or Student Portal

In Preparation for CAASPP and ELPAC Remote Testing


In the Spring Semester of 2021 many district students will be participating in Summative State Testing as part of the CAASPP and ELPAC programs. Due to the COVID-19 emergency and distance learning, it is likely that your student will be participating in the testing programs remotely from home. In order to participate successfully in remote testing, two important tasks must be accomplished:


- 1. The California Secure Browser must be installed on the student's device
- 2. The student must have their State Student Identification Number (SSID) to login to the secure browser

This applies to your student if they are <u>an English Learner in grades 2 and above</u>, **Or** your student is enrolled in <u>grades 3-8, 11, or 12.</u> This does not apply to students in Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and 1st grade.

This document contains instructions on how to obtain your student's SSID number through either the Aeries Parent or Student Portals. Because of a planned update to the Aeries Portals, two sets of instructions are included. Follow the set which matches the view you see on your screen upon login.


