For winter semi-formal or prom, guests must be under the age of 21.

No dance guest can be a middle school student.

All students wishing to attend the dance and bring a non-Early College High School guest must fill out and submit this form and abide by the following set of criteria. In order to give the Early College High School Administration ample time to look over and approve this guest pass and to allow for appeals, the following due date is not flexible and the school **will not approve late guest passes.**

All guests must attach a copy of their picture ID from their current school or their driver's license.

The photo ID must verify the age of the guest. A photocopy is acceptable if the text and picture is legible.

If the guest is under the age of 18, the guest's parent/guardian must sign for the following statement:

"I claim all responsibility for my child's actions as he or she attends this dance."

All guests must sign the behavioral commitment form describing all the behavioral expectations at Early College High School events on the reverse side of this sheet. All guests must be **under** the age of 21 (20 or under) on the night of the dance. No exceptions.

THE NIGHT OF THE DANCE:

Everyone must have a picture ID to get into the dance. Refunds will not be made.

Alcohol detection devices will be on the premises and used at the discretion of the ECHS Staff to determine admittance to the dance.

All attendees must arrive by 8:00 p.m. and all guests must arrive with their sponsor.

The guest, sponsor, sponsor's parent and the guest's parents will be held responsible for the behavior of the guest.

The school reserves the right to refuse entrance to the dance of any guest.

All attendees are expected to follow Early College High School and NMUSD rules at all times.

GUEST BEHAVIORAL COMMITMENT

All students attending an Early College High School activity, on or off campus, are expected to know appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by Early College High School. All students and parents should be aware of the following specifics regarding school activities:

As a result of action of the Board of Education on September 8, 2009, Section 11 of the Rules and Regulations of Policy #5144, General Student Conduct, now indicates the following:

- A. If you buy or sell drugs or alcohol at school or at school-related activities, or while traveling to and from school or school-related activities, you will be subject to expulsion from the School District.
 - B. If you are in possession of, or use, or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol at school or at school-related activities, or while traveling to and from school or school-related activities:
 - a) On the first occasion, you may be transferred to another school in the School District.
 - b) On the second occasion, you may be subject to expulsion from the School District.
1. Unless otherwise noted, the times of school formal and semi-formal dances are 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. There is no admittance to the dance after 8:00 p.m. and all guests must be picked up from the dance no more than 10 minutes after the dance has ended.
 2. Each guest must have an I.D. card.
 3. All guests must complete a guest pass form and turn it in with a photo ID that verifies name and age, to the Assistant Principal's Office prior to the dance. Pay close attention to the deadline date. All Early College students sponsoring a guest are responsible for the behavior of their guest.

All parents and students must read, understand and sign this agreement.

Early College High School encourages families to discuss these rules together with their students and to copy this document for future reference.

"I understand all school events are drug, alcohol and tobacco free. I agree to remain drug, alcohol and tobacco free at this school event. Furthermore, I have read and understand the above rules pertaining to behavior at school events. I understand the consequences for any inappropriate behavior. I further realize that all student activity tickets are not transferable. If I am unable to attend any activity because of a sudden emergency or some other unforeseen situation, I should notify the Activities Office immediately. I understand there are no refunds **after** the event. I understand that no bid or ticket may be sold or transferred from student to student.

ALL GUESTS MUST HAVE THIS COMPLETED AND ON FILE TO ATTEND THE ACTIVITY LISTED ON THE REVERSE OF THIS SHEET. STUDENTS WITHOUT A CONTRACT ON FILE, SIGNED BY THE STUDENT AND PARENT, WILL NOT BE SOLD AN ADMISSION TICKET TO THE EVENT.
