Recently, report cards were sent home with each student. The report card is designed to give you more information about your child's strengths, areas for growth, and classroom performance. At HHES, we use standards-based grading. This means that students are scored according to 'grade level' at this point in the year. Therefore, a 4 represents a student working 'above grade level' at this point in the year. A 3 represents students working 'at grade level' at this point in the year. A 2 represents students 'below grade level' but making progress toward grade level standards at this point in the year. A 1 represents students 'below grade level' and making little or no progress toward grade level at this point in the year.
