Thank you for helping us to plan for the school year by registering your child as soon as possible.

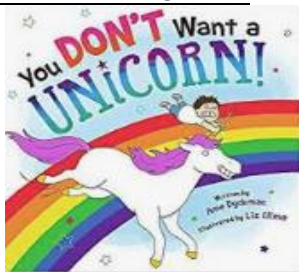
Bingo Night and Silent Auction
