

Information on Applying for a Boundary IN to HSD

Thank you for your inquiry for transfer to Hockinson School District (HSD).

Choice Transfers (out of district boundary exceptions) are required for **any** student who wants to attend HSD, but lives outside of our district's boundary. All requests need to start with your resident school district. You can find your resident school district by entering your address [here](#) (Clark County website).

- If you are a full time staff member at HSD and live outside the district, you need to fill out a Choice Transfer application yearly per [RCW 28A.225.225](#).
- Choice Transfers are valid for one school year only; you **must** reapply annually. Click [here](#) to reapply.
- Choice Transfer Requests (boundary requests) for the next school year will start being accepted **on and after the first Monday in May**, and will be processed in the order they are received and on an equal basis.
 - If you are new to HSD and your child(ren) boundary is approved, enroll your student [here](#).
- Families will receive a decision of an approval/denial via an email from Choice Transfer. Note: please check your spam folder.
- Participation in sports is not a valid reason for a boundary exception. The WIAA does not permit school transfers if the purpose for the request is to play sports at a non-resident school.
- The district does not provide transportation for students on boundary exceptions.
- Please Note: School districts may not make boundary decisions until late August for the upcoming school year. We encourage you to make alternate arrangements in the event the district is unable to accommodate your request.

More Information:

- If you are purchasing a home under construction in HSD, you may provide a letter from the builder confirming the projected occupancy date. A student who will reside in a new home in HSD, *on or before December 15 of the current school year*, may start as a resident student.
