

Things Parents & Students Should Know About "Logins", Passwords, and Email:

- **Students:** the MOST important thing is to *remember your login names and passwords*, and to have a working email address in case you need help with a login or password.
- **Students:** if you forget, the SECOND most important thing is to try to re-set or retrieve your password yourself or reach out to someone at school for help. See the yellow highlight below for where to get help.
- **Students:** a "district login" is what a student uses when they open their Chromebook. It's their student ID @nmusd.us, like 1100223@nmusd.us. This is NOT an email address, it is just used to log in.
- **Students:** Google Classroom uses the same login as above.
- **Student AND Parents:** SchoolLoop is at bbhs.schoolloop.com OR at backbay.nmusd.us. The login name and password for SchoolLoop are NOT the same as the district login.
- **PARENTS**, please set up a SchoolLoop account to monitor your student's progress. Go to bbhs.schoolloop.com, at the very bottom right of the page, click "login", and set up an account. You will need your student's ID number and a valid email address.
- **Students AND Parents:** If you don't have an email address you use and know the password for, set up a Gmail (Google) email at account.google.com.
