Lamar Elementary Dress Code 2023-2024

Lamar School will require students PreK – 5 grade to wear the dress uniform daily in order to cultivate excellence and promote esprit de corps. Lamar School has chosen Dennis Uniforms and Liberty Shop to supply uniform needs. To minimize misunderstandings relating to matters of student dress, we ask that all uniform items only be purchased from these sources.



Boys

- Long or short-sleeved white collared shirt with the Lamar logo
- Long-sleeved navy crewneck sweater or sweatshirt with logo
- A white base layer may be worn under a navy sweater/sweatshirt
- Khaki pleated, plain-front, or elastic waist dress slacks
 - (no blue jeans, cargo pants, sweat pants, wind pants or knit fabrics)
- Khaki pleated, elastic waist, or plain-front chino shorts
- Navy lightweight fleece jacket with logo
- Brown/Black Belt (required)

Boys are expected to be neatly groomed. Hairstyles must be neat, well-groomed and not extreme in color or style. Hair lengths must be cut above the eyebrows and cannot extend below the top of the collar or the bottom of the ear.

Girls

- Long or short-sleeved white collared shirt with the Lamar logo
- Long-sleeved navy crewneck sweater or sweatshirt with logo
- A white base layer may be worn under a navy sweater/sweatshirt Navy cardigan with logo
- Navy lightweight fleece jacket with logo Short-sleeved or long-sleeved knit
- Peter Pan white blouse with logo
- Classic navy large plaid shorts, skort or skirt (a-line or pleated)
- Classic navy large plaid poly/rayon blend jumper without logo
- Khaki pleated, plain-front, or elastic waist dress slacks
 - (no blue jeans, cargo pants, sweat pants, wind pants or knit fabrics)
- Navy ruffle knit dress with logo
- Navy biker shorts/Navy tights underneath skirts and jumpers

Clothing should be of sufficient length and loose enough to afford proper modesty. Dresses and skirts may be worn no shorter than four inches above the crease at the back of the knee. All tops must fit such that no skin is exposed at midriff or back while walking, sitting or during any range of motion. Hair styles must be neat, well-groomed and not extreme in color or style. No make-up. Body piercing is limited to the ear. Earrings are limited to studs. *PK **only** may wear a PK dress.

Footwear

<u>Tennis Shoe:</u> Shoes must have both closed toe and heel. The colors and design must complement the school uniform. No sandals, athletic slides, toe shoes, flip flops or Crocs are allowed.

<u>Dress Shoe:</u> Shoes must have both closed toe and heel, black, navy, or brown leather/suede in the following styles: loafers, wallaby, Merrill, Birkenstock, Mary Jane, oxfords and flats. Low-heeled boots are permitted for girls and boys.

<u>Boots</u>: Boots should hit below the knee. Boys may only wear boots with long pants (un-tucked). NO pointed cowboy boots are allowed. Rain boots are discouraged inside the building.

Socks: Sock colors include black, gray, red, navy and white. All socks must coordinate with uniform.
