Opened in 2002, Coyote Ridge Elementary School, home of the Coyotes, provides a creative, innovative, and engaging learning environment that focuses both on academics, as well as nurturing the social-emotional well-being of all our students.

We pride ourselves on providing experiences that focus on the development of the whole child. Our teachers and staff work collaboratively to ensure all students have the opportunity to succeed. We are proud of our students and encourage them to be the best they can be through our Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) structure. We explicitly teach, model, and practice our four school-wide expectations known as Cody's Code. These expectations are: Show Respect, Make Good Decisions, Solve Problems, and Be Safe.
