Guidelines for HMSA Reads

1. Every student needs to have free reading material every day. (Book or comic book) E-readers are ok.
 2. The book or comic book the student is reading must be listed on the student's reading log.
 3. All students in regular CP classes read at the beginning of class (2:10-2:30 PM suggested).
 4. The CP teachers check to make sure that all students have reading material that corresponds to what is on their reading log. (CP teacher signature optional)
 5. When the student finishes reading a book he must have his parent sign their initials in the appropriate space.
