RE: Implementation of School Uniforms

Dear Parent/Guardian;

As you may recall during the second semester of the 2014/2015 school year, written notices and telephone messages were sent to the homes of students attending Kornblum School, Ramona School, Bud Carson Middle School, Hawthorne Middle School and Prairie Vista Middle School regarding the implementation of a school uniform policy to begin during the 2015/2016 school year.

With the approval of our Board of Trustees, a mandatory school uniform policy is set to begin on January 11, 2016. This policy will require all students to wear a specified color and type of shirt and pant, short or skirt. Listed below is a brief summary of the policy as it pertains to each school named above.
