Netiquette DO's

Always

- Be respectful
- Be polite and kind
- Use academic language

When in Web Meetings:

- DO dress appropriate for school
- DO have a neutral, still background when possible
- DO find a quiet place when possible
- DO turn off your microphone unless you are speaking in the meeting
- DO use the chat function to let your teacher know you have a question.

Netiquette DO NOT's

Never

- Be rude, mean or a cyberbully
- Use text speak (LOL, SMH) or profanity

When in Web Meetings:

- DON'T dress inappropriately or have people or inappropriate items in your background
- DON'T leave your microphone on when you are not speaking
- DON'T talk or chat about off-topic items
- DON'T interrupt when others are speaking
- DON'T multitask (for example: no texting or playing games while in a meeting)
