## Y8 – Y13 Immersive Summer Work Experience



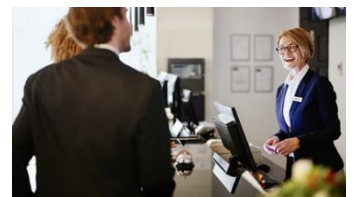
