## DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS

- Welcome and Introductions - Welcome everybody and thank you for being here tonight.
- Principal Report - We have all successfully returned to school. Everything has gone very smoothly and were delighted to have students back on campus. Distance learning is going well, too. LCAP is due May 11 - not a lot of decisions to be made or changes. Let's Go Learn will be used for assessment this year district wide. SRFACS will be doing a summer program this year. Jump Start will be the last 2 weeks in July depending on how many teachers we can get on board.
- TOSA Update - Three great new teachers are on board for next year. 6th graders will be able to take the A2 DELF exam this year here at SRFACS. Distance learners will be on campus for this as well. Last year's 6th graders may take the DELF next year.  
School Project (crucial for all French schools to maintain the accreditation) of documenting how to apply a harmonized curriculum for the success of each student and what support students need. The completed document will be presented next year.
- Classified Rep Report - All is going well.
- Certificated Rep Report - So nice to see the kids on campus. Collaborative time has been very helpful and is going well.
- PAF Report - The PAF by-laws were updated last month to keep in accordance with being a charter school. Setting up the budget for next year. Ben requested any financial
