Public Comments	7:45am Ms Leigh moved to start the meeting. Ms. Leigh reviewed the Parent Engagement Policy during Distance

Ms. Leigh introduced the Parent Compact. She asked the group for a vote and a second. Ms. Plascencia voted yes, Ms. Zebley approved. Parent Judith Barrera commented: everything looks good.

Ms. Leigh introduced the SPSA and action items. She asked the group for approval to review the budget. Ms. Whitaker moved to approve the budget. Ms. Iriarte seconded the vote.

Parent Q from Judith Barrera: Are we allowed to vote?

Ms. Leigh: Yes.

Ms. Zebley: Will this be opened up to all staff who may want to be involved?

Ms. Leigh: Yes, it will be offered to teachers.

Parent Q from Maria C.: Can you please elaborate on the parent groups (OTG Program)?

Ms. Whitaker: Here is a brief overview-OTG will involve 6th grade AA males and females. There will be two male cohorts that will have sessions with Dr. Earley from LMU. These sessions will include discussions around topics that relate to key issues (i.e. College and Career readiness, professionalism, AA community, social justice). The female cohort(s) will discuss similar issues as it relates specifically to females and will be led by our SSW and SW intern. Parents can participate in the orientation and parent workshops. Teachers will also participate through a focus group. This is upcoming.

Ms. Leigh reviewed more action items - instructional assistants. additional classified hours, for distance learning: books and reference materials, supplies, software programs, Chromebooks.

Ms. Leigh: This document is evolving as we meet the needs of students this school year.

Parent comment from Ms. Mendoza: In addition to e-books, are there hardcover books available?

Ms. Leigh: Yes, the school library is distributing books.

Ms. Zebley: Update on funds for sports.

ELPAC Assessment -Due to the pandemic, we were unable to complete

	<p>assessment last school year. This year in accordance with the state, there is a second chance to complete the assessment for the students who are close to being reclassified.</p> <p>This year there were 8 students that are very close to reclassification. Awaiting results from ELPAC initial and ELPAC summative to track progress and see if they are eligible for reclassification.</p> <p>The goal is for all students that are designated as English Learners to be reclassified.</p> <p>ELIRT supporting students from feeder elementary school Twain, FDR, Anderson.</p> <p>Test results will be available in 4 weeks.</p> <p>Support for EL students- There are Zoom sessions available to Newcomers students every Monday after advisory class. Students receive support in language, homework, questions, translations.</p> <p>Offering teachers sessions to discuss how to further support students who are English Learners and how to support in other classes.</p> <p>Offering Zoom sessions to students who are in need of additional support, need help from our social worker, aren't attending classes, and are under special circumstances.</p> <p>iReady Diagnostic- Supports English Learners. Students first took this diagnostic last month and will take it once again after winter break.
