Ms. Soto: Is there anyone who would like to share highlights from the DELAC or DPAC meeting?

Ms. Herrera and Ms. Rodriguez: We had difficulty accessing the Zoom meeting information.

Ms. Soto informed the group on ELPAC data based on grade levels on test domains (listening, speaking, reading, writing), reclassification criteria, and support for EL students.

Ms. Rodriguez: How many EL students are in the Dual Immersion (DI) Program? How are they being supported?

Ms. Soto: Of the 76 students enrolled in the DI Program, 17 are designated as EL students. And of those 17, 10 are newcomer students. I have weekly advisory support sessions for these students to help them with survival English and homework assignments. Additionally, Rogers has purchased Rosetta Stone for this group of students to support them with practicing survival English skills at home.
