Software - Various online platforms to enhance student instruction and support 21st century learning
Digital devices - purchases for Chromebooks, headsets, iPads, RISE partnership with AA student population
Additional conferences to serve as opportunities for teachers with professional development
Social Worker support - SEL support for students
Ms. Leigh - What other feedback and suggestions do you have?
Ms. Velasco - What is RISE? Is there a program for other subpopulations of students like Latinos?
Ms. Leigh - Yes, we will follow up. Parent workshops are also offered to all Rogers families. The next meeting topic is about campus safety. Later, topics include drug use and bullying. Partner with the school nurse to inform families about these topics.
Ms Whitaker - It is a program that is open for all students, but it is targeting AA students. It is designed to support students in this subpopulation Meet bimonthly. There is a parent component. Discuss black colleges and how it can be accessible to students.
Ms. Velasco - Will the sheriff deputy participate in these meetings?
Ms. Leigh - We plan to invite school site deputy. Will offer more opportunities for parents to attend meetings later on in the school year.
Ms. Herrera - CAFE conference. Opportunity for parents and teachers to attend to learn about how to support EL students
Ms. Leigh - Yes, we will look into this and connect with Dr. Kane about attending. We are also offering families on how to set up parent PowerSchool accounts. We are partnering with families and providing more opportunities
Ms. Herrera - Lunch tutors during lunches. Will that happen again?
Ms. Leigh - Northrop tutors. Plan to follow up with this organization. We are also working field trips and looking at funding to provide for students.
Ms. Herrera - Volunteer screening for field trips?
Ms. Leigh - Please email Ana (CL), for more information on how to apply.

8th grade: Level 4 - 5%, Level 3 - 42%,

Longitudinal Reclassification has increased each year
 2021-2 : 66 student reclassified
 This year already at 11 students that have reclassified this year
Reclassification Criteria:

1. ELPAC Level 4 overall
2. iReady at or adjacent level **or** STAR Reading At or Above **or** SBAC ELA upper two quartiles
3. B- or higher in ELA

Initial Supports for Students
 Newcomers:

- all students have Rosetta Stone account
- Bilingual IA support with language acquisition
- IA is placed to support student needs
- work with ELIRT and IAs during advisory

6th-8th grade Spanish Speaking

- Dual Immersion Program
- IA support in class based on need

6th-8th grade EL Students

- Designated ELD class
- Advisory support sessions
- ELD data chats
- Integrated ELD
- IA and ELIRT classroom support

 2 Spanish support and 1 Vietnamese support
 Mrs. Herrera: Data chats with students and add the parents too
 Ms. Soto: Students get a digital document with questions
 Ms. Velasco: Do the parents see the digital document?
 Ms. Soto: Access on PowerSchool
 Ms. Velasco: How many times do they test?
 Ms. Soto: If they reclassify using the criteria, they move into an elective class and do not test again.
