<p>Minutes</p>	<p>Ms. Leigh called the meeting to order at 4:05pm.</p> <p>Mr. Foster went over our software that our students are using to enhance their learning experience.</p> <p>Ms. Soto & Ms. Chumentowski went over the IA placement. The IA supports during classroom time to better support students one on one.</p> <p>Question: Are there different groups of students or do English and Spanish students overlap?</p> <p>Answer: Ms. Soto's group only supports English Learners Ms. Chumentowski supports English as well but it is subject to change.</p> <p>Ms. Quane on our Black Scholars RISE program : Rogers middle school partners with a non profit called " 100 Black men of LA". Last workshop is March 8th. Staff workshops are also available.</p> <p>Ms. Zebley: non profit organization that works with our RISE program says its been a positive influence on our students that are in the program.</p> <p>Ms. Blad-Johnson encourages our parents and students to visit our Rogers library and our public libraries. 12-10 free tutoring. There is a link in class link and you need your library card number and password. Resource workshops will be announced.</p> <p>Ms. Zebley: When are libraries opening?</p> <p>Ms. Blad-Johnson: Feb 1 is set for libraries to reopen.</p> <p>Ms. Soto-Reese : Reclassification Criteria students must score on a level 4 to be considered. Have a letter grade of B- or higher on language arts. 142 students need to take the ELPAC this year. ELPAC practice tests are available 24/7 www.elpac.org/resources/practicetests/. Links will be shared with families.</p> <p>Ms. Rodriguez asked to share with English language arts teachers. Ms. Soto-Reese approves.</p> <p>Ms. Centeno: Can the students practice at school?</p> <p>Ms. Soto-Reese: Yes Ms.Soto shared links with the ELD teachers to support students when they take the test.</p> <p>Ms. Centeno: How do you assess students that are below grade level? Are students aware of their grade level?</p>

	<p>Ms. Soto : Gives a report of their grade level and chats with the students. She talks about setting goals and what areas they need to improve on. She continues to talk with the students throughout the school year to see how they are progressing.</p> <p>Ms. Rodriguez: What can parents do at home to help support students?</p> <p>Ms. Soto: Links and resources will be provided to parents to help them.</p> <p>Mr. Gamboa: Are counselors coming in to talk to the students about reclassification?</p> <p>Ms. Soto: Counselors are not coming into classrooms to speak with our ELD students but, she will follow up with the counselors.</p> <p>Ms. Rodriguez: Make parents aware about ELD/reclassification students and how it will affect your student. A helpful tip will be to start informing parents & students as soon as they enter kindergarten.</p> <p>Ms. Leigh : Counselors go to elementary schools to talk to 5th graders about transitioning to Middle school. We can also ask our counselors to talk to students about reclassification.</p> <p>Ms. Leigh: Thank you for attending our next meeting will be 3/23/22</p> <p>Meeting ended 4:55pm 1/26/22</p>
