<p>Minutes</p>	<p>Ms. Leigh - Good Morning everyone and thank you for attending. We will review SPSA items.</p> <p>Mr. Foster - Site purchased technology software & digital tools overview. When and why digital tools are used, evaluation of digital tools & technology related site purchases(I.E i-ready, brainpop, discovery, padlet, comic life)</p> <p>Ms. Chumentowski - First priority is language arts and second priority is history, math, ELD etc. We have 3 IA's each class has about 5-10 focus students & support in all content areas but primary focus are ELA classes. They support all students. They are trained monthly as well.</p> <p>6th grade: 28 students supported - 22 students showed growth.</p> <p>7th grade 29 students supported 21 students showed growth.</p> <p>8th grade 55 students supported 30 showed growth.</p> <p>I - Ready is a reading tool and was piloted with the 6 grade classes. We targeted about 85 students. IA's have been assigned to these classes 1x a week to work in small groups. Iready was also used in small groups during advisory.</p> <p>Ms. Soto - Bilingual IA Placement! Following a similar protocol as Ms. Chumentowski. 3 Bilingual IA's working through ELIRT. I am also working on a program called Get Ready! Working in many subjects like math, science. When teachers have newcomers they give me a list of vocabulary terms and I make sure to cross reference on get ready to make sure newcomers get that extra support with those key terms.</p> <p>6th grade took the I ready diagnostics test more than once. Out of the 31 6th grade students, 23 showed growth. 7th grade 25 students took the test and 20 showed growth. 8th grade 37 took the test and 25 showed growth.</p> <p>Ms. Leigh - Our last meeting is May 3rd 9am-10am in room 26. We will be reviewing and providing input on our SPSA and Title 1 budget for next year. Thank you!</p>
