## Afterschool Pick-Up Procedures

**Car Riders:** All car riders will use the back entrance (door #8) for both drop off and pick up.

**\*\*\*Drop Off:** Enter the back parking lot. Stay in a single line next to the curb. Pull forward to the second cafeteria door (door #8). Remain in your vehicle as your student exits. Pull forward when he or she is safely on the sidewalk. Stay in line. Do not pull around other vehicles. Continue to follow the curb back to the fence, turning left and driving around the parking lot to exit onto Haberlein Road.

**\*\*\*Pick Up:** All families will receive a numbered card on the first day of school. When picking your child up after school, place this card in your passenger side window before getting in the pick up line. Enter the back parking lot. Stay in a single line next to the curb. Pull all the way forward to the back fence. A Poff staff member will dismiss your child from the building once your number has been identified. Please remain in your vehicle and pull away as soon as your child is safely inside. Do not pull around other vehicles.

**Walkers:** Students who are walked to school by an adult may be escorted to the main entrance in the front of the building or to door #8. After school, a Poff staff member will walk students across the street to the intersection of Marie and Haberlein where an adult should be waiting to greet the student.
