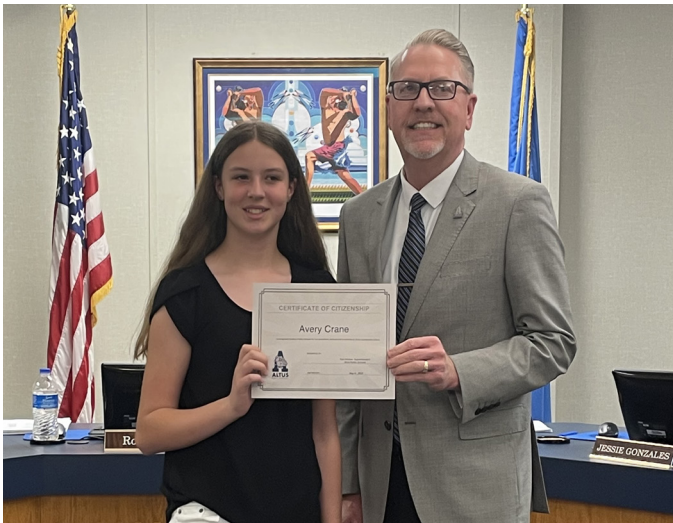


Board of Education Highlights

Superintendent's Report
