




Adult Transition Program

The focus of Temple City Unified School District Adult Transition Program (ATP) is to provide for maximum independence for young adults with differing intellectual abilities (ages of 18-22) in the areas of independent living, vocational experiences, community integration, and recreation/leisure. Additionally, it is within these areas that the young adults and their families work collaboratively with district staff and community stakeholders in determining individual needs, personal interests, and required skills. The team also develops strategic plans for leading independent, productive lives.




Temple City Virtual Academy

TC Virtual Academy is a tuition-free public high school within Temple City Unified School District offering students in grades K-12 the opportunity to earn a high school diploma online. Utilizing a digital curriculum, high school core courses and many elective courses are University of CA a-g approved for UC/CSU Admissions. In middle school, grades K-8 standards-based courses are provided through a digital curriculum. Credentialed teachers are available daily online to provide student assistance and progress monitoring. Students complete coursework in a much more flexible, self-directed manner than in a traditional classroom.


