All Elementary Schools

- 1 large backpack (no wheels)
- 1 pair of tennis shoes for Physical Education class
- 1 pair of headphones (no bluetooth or earbuds)
- 1 school supply box, 5x8 inches
- 1 pair of scissors, blunt tip
- 24 plain wooden pencils, #2 (no mechanical pencils or sharpeners)
- 2 large erasers
- 1 pack of colored pencils, 8-10 pencils
- 4 boxes of crayons, 24 count
- 1 set of washable watercolor paints, 8 colors
- 1 box of fine-tip washable markers, classic colors, 10 count
- 1 box of broad-tip washable markers, classic colors, 10 count
- 4 chisel-tip dry erase markers, black
- 4 fine-tip dry erase markers, black
- 6 large (or 12 small) glue sticks
- 3 plastic pocket folders with clips (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow)
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 1 large pack of sticky notes, 3x3 inches (like Post-It Notes)
- 1 large (or 2 small) packages of disinfecting/sanitizing wipes
- 2 boxes of facial tissue, large (like Kleenex)
- 1 box plastic storage bags (like Ziploc)

 - If your last name starts with M-Z, bring gallon-size plastic bags
