### **Narrative Writing Rubric Score Rationale for Second Grade Score of 3**

This writing sample received an overall rubric score of 3. The writing is well developed. However, it does not have a clear narrative voice. The writing goes back and forth between first and third person. It has some mistakes in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling, but they do not hinder the overall meaning.

## Narrative Writing

<b>4</b>	The response is well developed. It includes all of the features of narrative writing: details about the time and place, a logical sequence of events, well-developed characters, dialogue, and a narrative point of view. The writer uses conventions of grammar and sentence structure correctly and has few or no mistakes in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling.
<b>3</b>	The response is adequately developed. It has most of the features of narrative writing but may not have a clear narrative voice. The writer uses conventions of grammar and sentence structure correctly most of the time and may make some mistakes in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling, but they do not hinder meaning.
<b>2</b>	The response is somewhat developed. It includes some of the features of narrative writing but includes few details and may not present a logical sequence of events. The writer uses conventions of grammar and sentence structure correctly some of the time and makes many mistakes in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling, which hinder the overall meaning.
<b>1</b>	The response is undeveloped. It shows little understanding of narrative writing and does not include details of time or place or a logical sequence of events. The writer rarely uses conventions of grammar and sentence structure correctly and makes many mistakes in capitalization, punctuation, and spelling, which hinder the overall meaning.
<b>0</b>	The response does not fit the writing prompt or is incomplete.
