
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Absent half a day every week

1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons MISSED!!!


38 school weeks

= 1/2 a school year missed!




What impact might this have on Johnny's life.....?


Research suggests that even 6 missed school days a year = DROP in academic achievement. The greater the attendance the greater the achievement.

So 90% is not as good as it first seemed.

What can do as a parent to increase my child's attendance?



Ways for parents to encourage attendance:

1. MOST IMPORTANT! Only grant days at home for genuine illness. You will know if they are ill, but if in doubt, bring them to school and have the Health Clerk check!

 Check on your child's attendance record and verify that it matches with your own record.

Ways for parents to encourage attendance:

- 3. Talk regularly with your child about school and how they feel about it. They are more likely to attend if they feel supported.
- 4. Phone us as soon as possible to tell us why your child is absent and when you expect them to return.
- Avoid taking holidays or vacation trips during school time.



Ways for parents to encourage attendance:

- Know routines of the school day to avoid issues (e.g. do they have their PE clothes?)
 If you have concerns call us we will check attendance and be discreet.
 PRAISE AND REWARD GOOD
 - ATTENDANCE: good attendance, including promptness, should be recognized so your child sees how important it is to be in school everyday!

Other tips to help secure good attendance:



1. If there is a problem with your child's attendance, talk calmly to your child and listen to the explanation. Crys for help can be manifested in various ways. Pursuing the reason for non attendance is important.

2. Talk to us to resolve issues. We may be able to help and support you and your child. You are not alone.



Other tips to help secure good attendance:

3.

Be particularly watchful and supportive in your child's participation in school and be aware of coursework deadlines.

Check homework regularly as well as AERIES.net portal to see how your child is progressing in school.

 Assist your child to make sure they catch up on missed work. An absence does not mean missed work.

6. Remember **PRAISE** for good attendance.
