

## 7th Grade Project

- 1. Look/listen/and learn (Discuss with your partner)
- 2. Ask lots of questions (What will you research?)
- 3. Understand the problem or process (Research and learn!)
- 4. Navigate ideas (Make a plan)
- 5. **C**reate (Make your project)
- 6. **H**ighlight what's working and failing (Reflect)
