difficult.

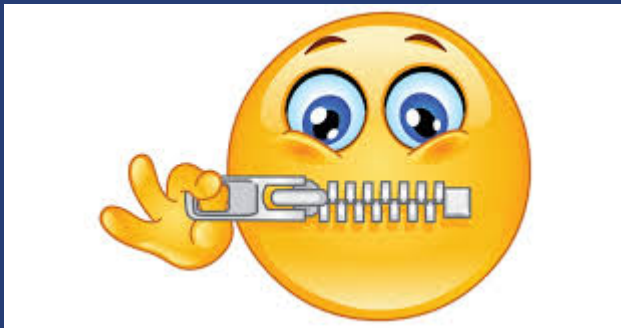

4. Be a good friend...don't share secrets.

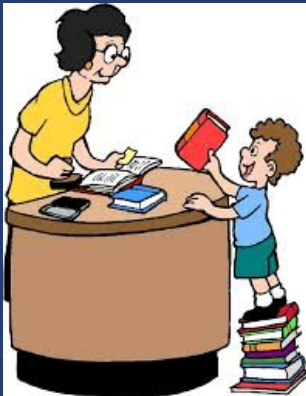
What might happen if you share

How Can We Show Trustworthiness?

- Always tell the truth
- Be loyal to friends and family
- Don't cheat or steal
- Do what you say you will do
- Keep your promises
- Keep private information, private
- Don't tell secrets
- Don't say or do things that could hurt others
- Take care of and return borrowed items
- Turn in items to the Lost & Found
