Examples	Non-Examples
Walking on blacktop	Running on blacktop
Sliding down the slide	Crawling up the slide
Hands & feet to yourself	Rough play/wrestling
Walking on blacktop and running on the grass area	Playing tag on blacktop and in the bark box
Respecting playground equipment	Throwing bark or sand/destroying property
Walk to the line	Run to the line/continue playing

Examples & Non-Examples

Examples	Non-Examples
Getting water during recess	Getting water after the bell rings
Using the restroom during recess	Using the bathroom after the bell rings
Stop playing when bell rings	Keep playing when bell rings
Student is responsible for their personal belongings (jackets, sweaters, lunch bags)	Student leaves jacket, sweater, and lunch bag outside or in the hallway

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
