



Documents for Verification and Types of Income

CHILD'S AGE

Copy of birth certificate

OR

Copy of hospital record

OR

Copy of immunization record

OREGON RESIDENCY

Current utility or service bill

OR

Oregon driver's license

OR

Other identification card

Please note that if you do not have copies of the required documents, there are alternate ways to certify birthdate, address, and income. Please contact the Marion & Polk Early Learning Hub.

ANNUAL GROSS FAMILY INCOME

Income tax form 1040 or 1040A

OR

12 months' worth of pay stubs

OR

Form W-2

OR

Documentation of foster care status

ADDITIONAL INCOME TO BE VERIFIED:

Child support or alimony payments
Unemployment
Social Security or other retirement
Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
Worker's compensation
Veteran's benefits
Pensions
Insurance or annuity payments
Scholarships, grants, or stipends
Dividends, interest
Rental income
Other periodic income sources

The following types of income are NOT counted:

Federal stimulus payments, incl. supplement to unemployment
Capital gains (profits from the sale of an asset)
Tax refunds
Gifts or loans
One-time insurance benefits
Non-cash benefits such as employer-paid health insurance
Food or housing received in lieu of wages
Non-cash assistance (Medicaid, SNAP, school meals, housing)
