## SAT

The Scholastic Aptitude Test is used as one eligibility requirement for college admission. It is accepted by many colleges and universities including all California public universities (as of date of publication, the University of California system is evaluating the use of the SAT as an admissions tool). The SAT consists of two areas of educational development: math and verbal.

### SAT SUBJECT TESTS

Subject Tests are subject area admissions tests required by the more competitive colleges and universities, including the University of California, as well as many private colleges and universities. Some subject areas include: physics, chemistry, Spanish and French.

### SENDING SAT SCORES

The ACT is a national college admissions examination that consists of subject area tests in English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. ACT results are accepted by all four-year colleges and universities in the US.
