A.P. U.S. History is an 11th grade course that is an advanced placement course.

Course Description:

A.P.U.S.H. is an extremely rigorous course. The class is a college level history class for which students take the national A.P. exam at the end of the course and may qualify for collegiate credit from their future college/university. Daily reading is an expectation in the course and central to student success. Timed exams, primary source analysis, in class essays, dynamic discussion are all daily components of the course. Students do earn a "G.P.A. bump" for taking the class.

Recommended Pre-Reqs:

Overall 3.5 GPA minimum, A.P. English Grade B or Better, Regular English Grade A or better, A.P. Social Studies Grade B or Better, Regular Social Studies A or better.
