

11th Grade U.S. History Blended Course Information

For 2021-2022 School Year

Course Description: The blended section of 11th grade U.S. History will combine an online learning environment with the face-to-face traditional learning atmosphere. Students will engage in many different forms of independent learning with the support of the teacher via both the online platform and the traditional face-to-face setting.

Student Information

The successful student in blended U.S. History is independently driven and motivated. Students must be able to adhere to deadlines and be able to manage their independent workload outside of traditional class time. Advanced planning and time management are vital in order for a student to be successful in this learning environment. Students will regularly be asked to complete learning tasks through the online platform and be required to be able to meet deadlines on their own.

Learning Structure

This class will combine both online and face-to-face learning. Students will attend the class in a face-to-face setting during the first block period of the week and during the other periods, students will have learning tasks to complete on their own in accordance with various deadlines and schedules. During the online learning days, the teacher will be available for office hours during the block period to meet with students and provide extra instruction and help.

Sample Two Week Schedule

For example, if the class is 1st period...

- Monday (A) – students come to a traditional class during 1st period block
- Wednesday (A) – students have online learning
- Friday (A) – students have online learning
- Tuesday (A) – students come to a traditional class during 1st period block
- Thursday (A) – students have online learning

- Have a B- or better in World History
- Get a teacher recommendation from their current Social Studies teacher
- Have an overall 3.0 or better GPA
