Fentanyl is a potent opioid analgesic medication sold illegally on the streets as a counterfeit pill to unsuspecting teens seeking relief from pain and anxiety. Between 2019 and 2021, Fentanyl-related teen deaths rose 1800% in Orange County, now the local leading cause of death for minors. Sergeant Brian Gunsolley with the Orange County Sheriff's Department will provide parents and guardians with valuable life-saving information about the fentanyl crisis and how to reduce the risk of accidental overdose.
