<p>EOC - End of Course Four high school assessments required prior to graduation: Algebra I (Algebra II), Biology, English II, & Government</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Algebra I & English II <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Timing: 180 - 220 minutes • Biology & Government <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Timing: 55 - 80 minutes • Algebra II (required for students completing Algebra I prior to high school) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Timing: 190 - 220 minutes • Test score reports are provided to parents during fall parent/teacher conferences • Test scores are 10% of a student's final grade for the tested course 	<p>Last week of April - first week of May</p>
<p>ACCESS for EL Required for K-12 students identified as English Learners (EL)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tested in four domains: Listening, Reading, Speaking, Writing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Timing: Around 35 - 65 minutes depending upon domain being tested • Score reports are mailed home to parents in May 	<p>Second week of January - last week of February</p>
