Employment Opportunities:

According to O*Net Online, the job outlook for the Cosmetology field should grow 10 to 14% by 2026. The 2017 average national pay was an annual salary of \$24,850. The job outlook for Hair Salon Managers shows a field growth of 15% by 2026 with a 2017 average national pay of \$37,450.

Licensing:
