Student Eligibility Requirements for Club Participation and Competition:

All students participating in the Northern California Esports League (NCEL) must meet the minimum eligibility requirements for club participation regardless of where the Club is located (school or community-based organization):

- NCEL Club participation is open to middle school students.
- The middle school student must enroll in the NCEL Club at their middle school or a community-based organization.
- The middle school student is currently enrolled a middle school or community-based organization as defined in the Club Eligibility guidelines (available online at www.esportsfed.org)
- The middle school student maintained satisfactory citizenship (no N or U) during previous grading period at a middle school or is good standing at the community-based organization.
- The middle school student must have earned a grade point average of 2.0 or better in all subjects during the previous grading period preceding his/her participation.

Permission to Play Online and Online Communication Agreement

- I acknowledge that I am giving my child permission to play games online against other schools. Every effort will be made to protect my student and all claims regarding student misconduct will be investigated.
- I acknowledge that if my child is found to be in violation of any of the terms of the Code of Conduct or any school or community organization policies, that their eligibility to participate in the NCEL's Esports program may be permanently and irrevocably voided.
- Any verbal harassment, cyberbullying, cheating or other violation as decided upon by the school administration may result in a permanent ban from ALL NCEL Esports programs and competitions.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to monitor my child's online communication, and that when communicating online there are inherent risks.
- I understand that if my child's school or community organization is using Discord or another alternative platform, that their school can only monitor chat within their own server, and that it is my responsibility to moderate my child's behavior in any other server or privately held conversation. My child's school or community organization assumes no liability for communications held using Discord or an alternative communication platform.

CONSENT, INDEMNIFICATION, WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT (MINOR)

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the child's whose name is written below ("My Child") participation in activities and use of any premises and facilities related to the Northern California Esports League (the "NCEL") and the North America Scholastic Esports Federation (the "Federation"), including transportation to and from, and any equipment supplied to My Child or used by My Child in connection therewith (collectively, "Participation"), to the fullest extent permitted by applicable laws I agree as follows:

1. I hereby grant My Child permission for his/her Participation. I acknowledge and I am aware of the hazards, dangers and risks (inherent or otherwise) in connection with the Participation and being a spectator, including, without limitation, property damage, property loss, property theft, economic loss, accident, minor injury or serious injury (known or unknown), which may include permanent disability or paralysis, or death to me, My Child, to other participants, to spectators or other third parties. I acknowledge and am aware of the inherent risks associated with participating in online gaming events and on an online platform. I am aware and release all parties from any liability associated with my Child participating in an online gaming platform and further agree that **My Child will not release any personally identifying information regarding themselves or others to any parties online through any communication means, written, verbal, or other.** I further acknowledge that there are natural factors and occurrences which may impact or affect the safety of the Participation. I warrant that My Child is in good health and has no physical conditions that would prevent My Child from being involved in or acting in connection with the Participation. **I assume full responsibility for, and all risk of, any accident, bodily injury, death, property loss, property theft or property damage that may result for any reason, including by acts of negligence, in connection with the Participation or being a spectator, whether caused by The NCEL, BCOE, All Participating Schools and Community Organizations, The Federation, Samueli Foundation, H&S Ventures, UCI Esports, Orange County Department of Education, Orange County STEM Initiative, Connected Learning Lab, Connected Camps, University of California Irvine and/or its or their parent, related, affiliate, successor and/or subsidiary companies and/or their respective owners, officers, advisors, directors, members, employees, agents, vendors, subtenants, landlords and/or sublandlords (collectively, the "Releasees"), me, My Child, another participant, any third persons or otherwise.**

2. I agree that prior to participating or allowing My Child to participate in any activity related to the NCEL or the Federation, including the Participation, I will inspect the premises and surrounding area, all equipment to be used and the nature and source of the opposing participants. If through my inspection I determine that anything related to the Participation is unsafe or otherwise

unacceptable to me or My Child, I will immediately advise an official of the NECL or the Federation of the condition and will not participate or allow My Child to participate until the condition is corrected.

3. If My Child becomes injured or ill as a result of the Participation, I authorize the Releasees to administer, or cause and consent to the administration of, whatever first aid, medical care, dental care or other treatment and medications as may be necessary under the circumstances, including treatment by a physician, emergency medical technician, dentist or hospital ("Treatment"), although I acknowledge that the Releasees have no obligation to do so and that the Releasees do not endorse the services of any physician or hospital that may provide such Treatment to My Child. I understand that I will be financially responsible for the cost of any such care, treatment or medication and that the Releasees will have no obligation to pay any such costs of any Treatment and agree to reimburse the Releasees for any such costs incurred.

4. **I RELEASE, AGREE NOT TO SUE AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS (ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND MY CHILD) THE RELEASEES of and from any and all claims, causes of action, suits, demands, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, expenses and any actions of any kind whatsoever (collectively, "Claims")**, known or unknown, existing now or in the future, that I, My Child, our respective heirs, executors, administrators, next of kin, assigns or any third party may now or hereafter have against the Releasees, arising in any way as a result of or in connection with the Participation and any Treatment, including, without limitation, any property damage, property loss, property theft, bodily injuries, disability, death or other damage suffered by me, My Child, our respective heirs, executors, administrators, next of kin and assigns or any other party regardless of any fault or passive or active negligence on the part of the Releasees, myself, My Child or any third party.

NCEL/NASEF Media Release

5. **I grant to the Releasees a non-exclusive license** to use the likeness, image, voice, photograph and/or name of me and My Child for any and all commercial and non-commercial purposes in perpetuity including, in connection with the marketing, promotion and/or advertising of the Federation and/or the Releasees and/or their respective services in any form or media known and unknown or hereinafter developed without geographic or time restrictions, without the right of prior inspection or approval and without further considerations, royalties or payment of any kind.

6. This Agreement constitutes my entire understanding regarding the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes any prior statements, agreements or representations (written or oral) regarding that subject matter. No oral representations, statements or inducements apart from this Agreement as written have been made. I agree that this Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, such invalidity will not affect any other provision that can be given full effect without the invalid provision. The laws of the State of California shall apply to and govern this Agreement, without regard to conflicts of laws principles, and I on behalf of myself and My Child consent to the jurisdiction and venue of the federal, state and local courts located in Butte County, California.

7. I have carefully read this Agreement, and I know and understand what it means, including that it is a complete waiver and release of liability and promise on behalf of myself and My Child to indemnify and not to sue or make a claim. My signature below is my own free and voluntary act and I intend this Agreement to be legally binding on me. I certify that I am at least 18 years old.

8. I represent that I am a parent and natural guardian or legal guardian of the child named below with the legal authority necessary to agree to the terms of this Agreement, I am, in fact, acting in such capacity and agree to save and hold harmless and indemnify the Releasees from all claims, suits, demands, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, expenses and any actions whatsoever, whether known or unknown, which may be made against the Releasees because of any defect in or lack of such capacity to so act and hereby release the Releasees on behalf of the child listed below and his/her parent(s) or other legal guardian(s).
