1. Announcements-
 - a. Tomorrow is student led conferences.
 - b. We are now considered Title One. Trini and Michelle are going to meet with Title One people and are proposing- AVID they pay for the program and the school pays for travel, Licenses for Read 180 and Math 180, iReady, possible tech refresh (no idea of how many), STEM and STEAM materials, after school tutoring \$22 per hour stipend, agendas, binders, AVID supplies, community relations personnel (bridge between outside businesses, community, etc. and our school to help bring in resources).

3. Advocacy

4. Tardies

The teachers would like the students to call home when they get swept. The office will plan to do them in the future, and they won't tell us when.
