Heads Up - Act 158

- COVID Keystone Exemptions
 - If you took Algebra I, Biology, or Literature during 2019-2020, you are automatically Proficient on that specific Keystone exam
- If you have NOT yet scored Proficient on all three Keystone Exams by Senior year, there are other pathways to graduation that you must follow to satisfy state requirements
 - We will meet with students affected by this at the beginning of May to provide more information
