Overview

- Dallas College Board approved expanded partnership with FISD
 - FISD will provide equipment and facilities for Dallas College instructional use
 - Dallas College will provide full tuition scholarships to FISD students for dual credit classes
 - 1st attempts only
 - Textbook/learning material costs will not be covered by Dallas College
 - Dallas College will allow the Forney Family to pay in-district tuition for qualified courses

 - Notification Deadline for Fall – September 11th
 - Notification Deadline for Spring – October 19th
- Fisd will provide verified list of Forney Family students to EFC
- Complete steps 5 and 6 of the [Dallas College Enrollment Process](#)
 - Registration deadline for classes that start October 19 – October 5th
 - Registration deadline for Spring classes that start January 19 – December 7th





Tuition – Forney Family

- In-District Tuition - \$79 per credit hour
- Out-of-District Tuition - \$135 per credit hour

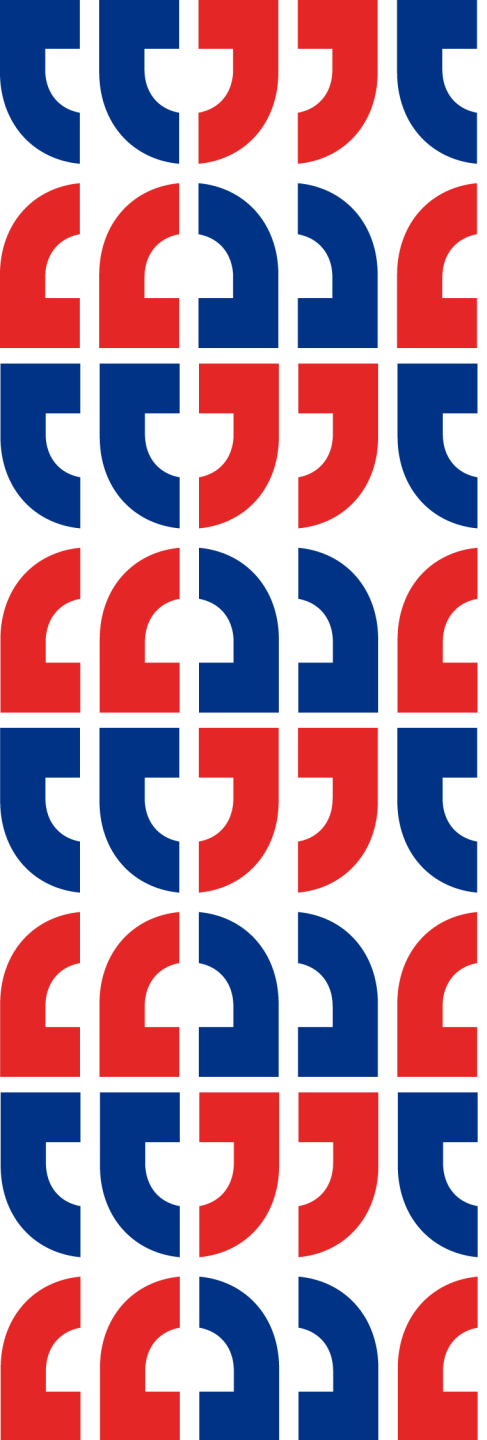




Things to Remember
