



FORNEY ISD HEALTHY PRACTICES

Forney ISD monitors any health risks that arise in our community. The district follows guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS), and the Texas Education Agency (TEA). Below are our health practices for each campus.



HAND HYGIENE

Hand sanitizing stations are available at all district facilities.

Staff will be expected to regularly wash or sanitize their hands.

Students will be required to regularly wash hands throughout the school day.



CLASSROOM CLEANING

Frequent cleaning and disinfecting will promote a healthy learning and work environment for students and staff.

Each classroom will have a hand sanitizer station.

Each classroom and restroom, as well as all high-touch areas, will be disinfected regularly.



COUGH ETIQUETTE

We ask that everyone cover their nose/mouth when they cough/sneeze.

Please socially distance when possible.

Face coverings for all students are encouraged, but remain optional.

Wash hands frequently.



STAY HOME IF SICK

Staff are required to self-screen for symptoms of illness, such as fever or vomiting, prior to reporting to work each day.

Parents are expected to screen their students for symptoms of illness, such as fever or vomiting, prior to sending their student to school.

Students who are ill will be separated from their peers and should be picked up within 30 minutes from the time the campus contacted the student's parent/guardian.
