

How to access Interim assessment and Summative data in CERS

The **California Educator Reporting System (CERS)** provides teachers and administrators with access to individual and aggregate student results from state summative and interim assessments. Note: **Interim assessments containing short answer or PT items will populate in CERS after the items are hand scored and assigned as completed in the Interim Hand Scoring System.**

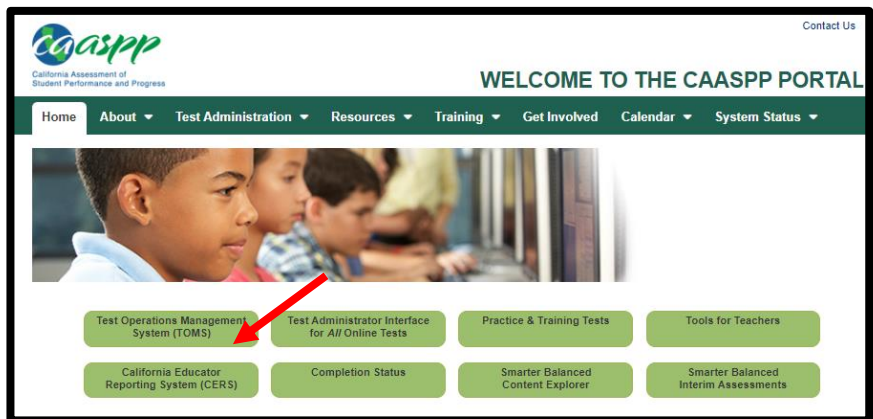

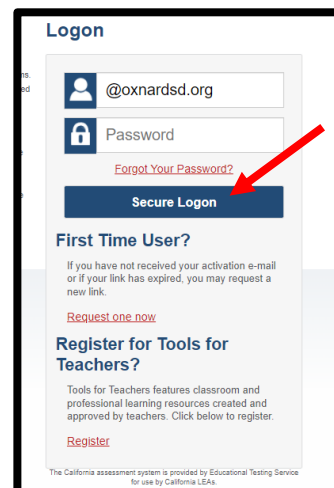

1. Go to <https://www.caaspp.org/> and click [Test Operations Management System \(TOMS\)](#) tile in green.

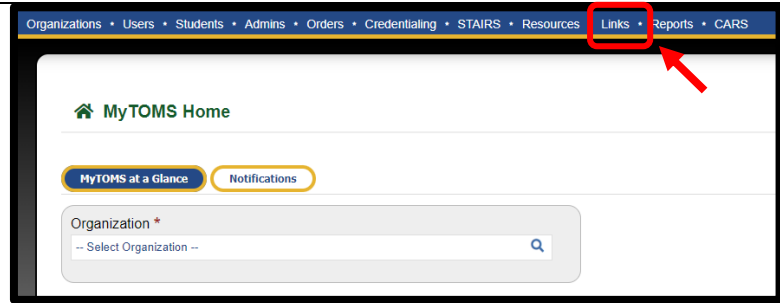


2. You will be prompted to log in using your TOMS log in credentials.

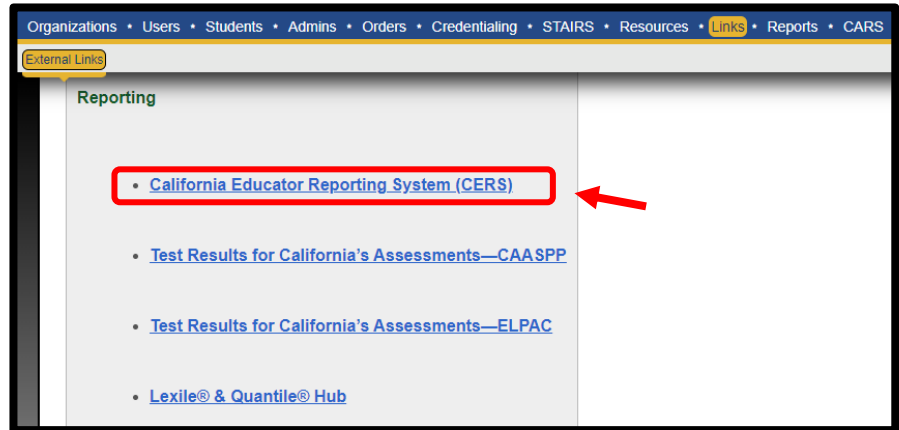

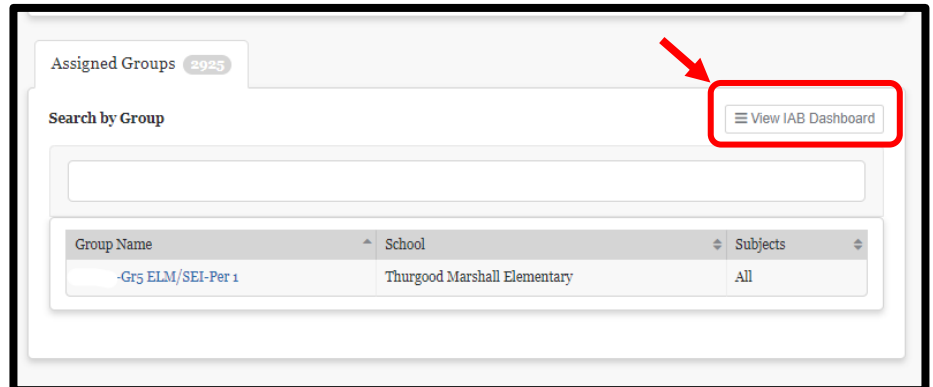
3. Click on the *Links* tab, located on the blue banner.



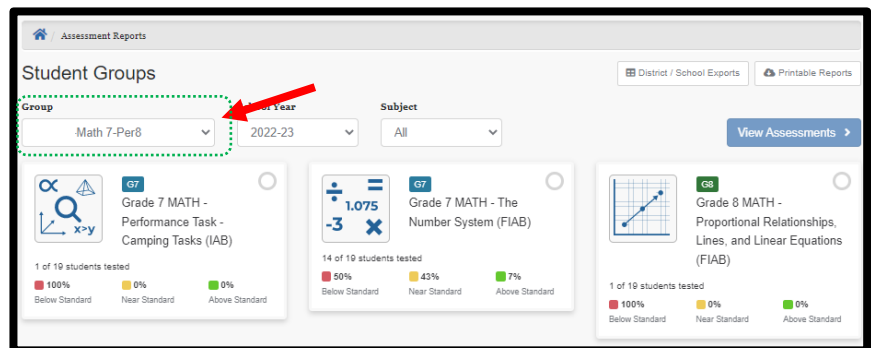
4. Under the 'Reporting' section, click the *California Educator Reporting System (CERS)* link.



5. Once you've been redirected to a new tab, find the 'Assigned Groups' section (listed, in blue, are the rosters you are assigned to). Click the *View IAB Dashboard* link.



6. Users with multiple class periods will need to select a class period, under the *Group* drop down menu (green).

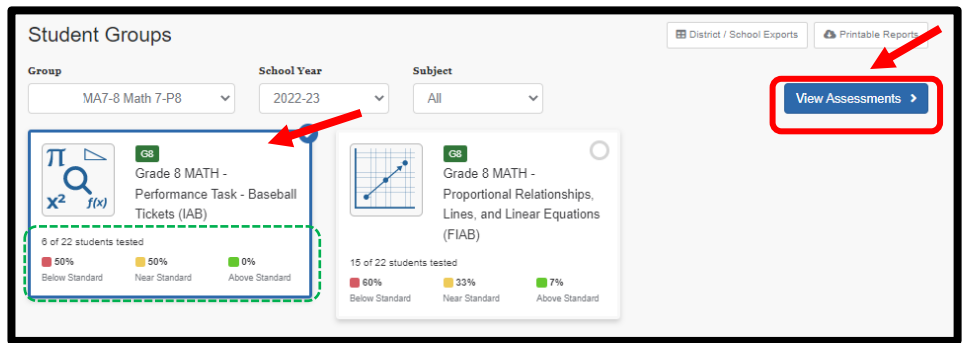


7. Select the appropriate IAB tile and click the View Assessments tile.

In the example on the right, we will select the Gr. 8 Math – PT IAB

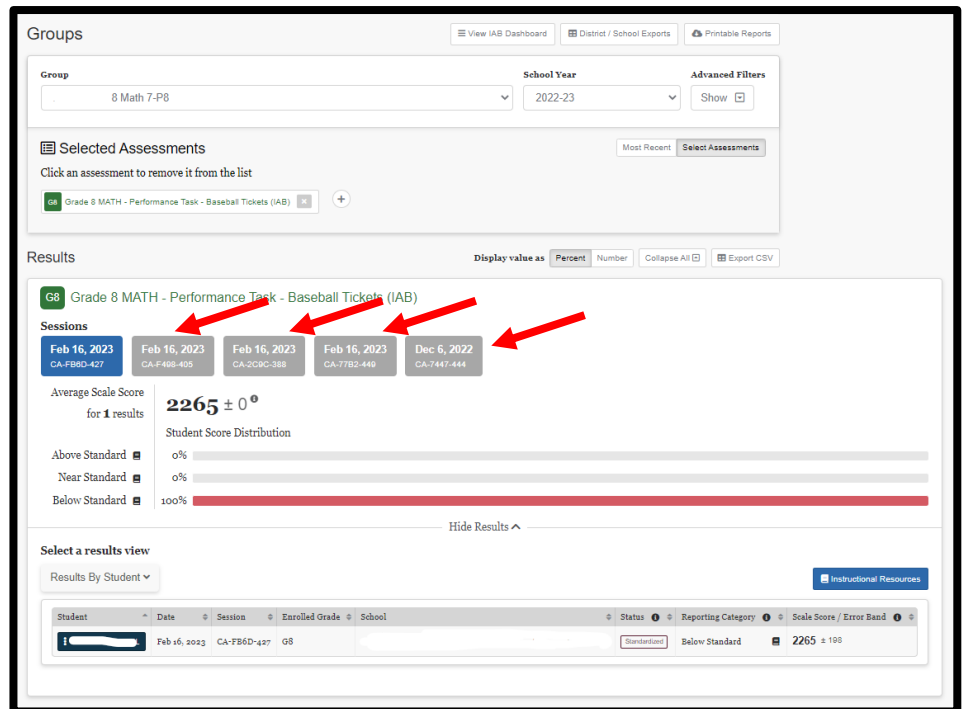
Each tile is an at a glance summary of the number of students tested (6 out of 22) and the level these tested students scored in (50% below standard and 50% Near Standard).

For results to populate in CERS, PT or short answer items must be scored in the Interim Hand Scoring System first.



8. Under the Sessions section, select any 'grayed out' tiles. The tiles containing the dates & Session ID should be colored in blue after selecting.

In the example on the right, 5 different session IDs were used to administer the Gr. 8 PT IAB for students assigned to this 'group/roster.'



9. Here you can access student results.
