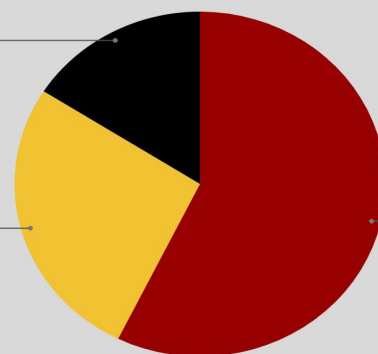

COVID -19 Response

On March 13, 2020, distance learning was implemented for all students for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. The district rolled out a tiered intervention and academic plan to allow students and staff to integrate into using the technological tools available and to supply students with one to one chromebooks. Students received letter grades for course work through the end of the 2019-2020 school year. The 2020-2021 school year remained in the Distance Learning model. We are offered a block schedule consisting of 3 six-week trimesters with two classes offered at a time. Our AP courses are included in this expedited block, therefore students taking H/AP courses are accessing the curriculum in a rigorous and challenging manner. We continue to offer Dual Enrollment courses and CTE courses with our partners in Ventura County. Students are held accountable for attendance and graded assignments and exams.

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Programs at a Glance

Athletics - Over 40% of SVHS student body participates in 1 or more sports.
Arts - SVHS offers over 20 courses in visual and performing arts including video production, theater, dance, choir, guitar, digital photography, and drawing.
Clubs - SVHS students can choose from over 50 clubs to participate in.

Faculty

87 teachers, all of whom hold a B.A. or B.S. degree and teaching credentials in their field of teaching.
Over 50% of the faculty possess masters or doctorate degrees. The staff also includes two National Board Certified teachers.

All courses taken in 9-12, including courses taken at accredited programs outside the district during the summer, are included in the cumulative GPA. The **WEIGHTED** GPA is determined by adding an extra point to any grade point value in an AP or designated Honors courses where the final grade is an A, B or C in a semester. Community College Dual Enrollment Courses are included and also are weighted up to 4 classes. Dual Enrollment classes may be used to meet a graduation requirement. Simi Unified School District does class ranking by a combination of overall GPA and course rigor.

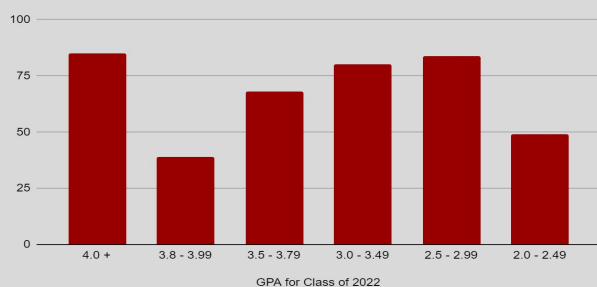
