## **Meeting Minutes**

1. Call to Order & Recognition of Quorum:

2. Approval of the Agenda

4. Approval of November 3, 2015 Meeting Minutes

5. Public input from individuals wishing to address the committee

6. Discussion
  - Review Property Valuation Report

- Review Previous Information  
The Committee reviewed information presented at the previous meetings regarding the Community High School, possible CTE opportunities, the first right of refusal guidelines, and charter schools.

7. Discussion and Preparation of Site Disposition Recommendation(s) to Board of Education

Based on the information that had been provided, the Committee unanimously determined to make the following recommendation to the Board of Education: The District Advisory (7-11) Committee unanimously recommends that the Board of Education retain the site and not declare it as surplus to allow the District to explore needs such as the expansion of career technical opportunities for students and to allow for other educational opportunities as deemed necessary and feasible.

Ron LaGuardia, chair, requested consideration to also include the following suggestions to the recommendation: 1) Create the site into a career technical education themed school/vocational academy/post-secondary preparation academy; and 2) Transition THS@MC program to the site and allow for dual enrollment and also include elements of career technical education programs.

After further discussion, the Committee determined to keep the recommendation as originally prepared/presented to not restrict the District and Board of Education regarding possible uses and program opportunities that can be housed at the location.
