Classroom Snack Food News

Moorpark USD School Board has established a nutrition policy requiring healthy food choices at schools to be the standard. The rise in childhood obesity, diabetes and food allergies is a concern requiring schools to intervene by providing nutrition guidelines. Food lunches: Lunch and recess snacks brought from home must be marked specifically for your child. Sharing of this food is not allowed at any time. Food for class parties: Home cooked food items or baked goods will not be allowed. To comply with the County Health and FDA recommendations, food items at parties should be a healthy choice of fruit or vegetables. MUSD will provide a preferred Classroom Celebration and Snack Menu making acceptable items available for purchase. Parents will not be allowed to bring in treats outside these guidelines.

Flory students, faculty, and parents will be marching with our school banner in the Moorpark Country Days Parade on Saturday, October 5th. You can either wear your Flory shirt or costume to promote our carnival. There will be a permission slip going home.
