We are pleased to announce the LCAP survey results are in! Some of the feedback you gave us include top priority items of class size, school safety, STEAM. MUSD will continue to maintain class sizes of 24:1 for grades TK-3 and will strive to maintain current class sizes in grades 4-12. MUSD will also continue to work with law enforcement to ensure campus safety. MUSD will also continue to offer and expand enrichment opportunities focused on STEAM within the district. We are also excited to announce that we will be implementing a Positive Behavior Interventions Support System starting in August. Our staff has been working hard to develop school wide expectations for all of our students. These expectations will be extremely helpful for students since they travel to different teachers throughout the day (math, science, computer lab, library, enrichment, and possibly ELD to name a few). By developing and teaching school wide expectations, we lower student anxiety out of what to expect from different school settings. Expectations don't change although the adult in charge might. We will be providing you with a copy of all of the expectations at the beginning of the year so you can review them with your child. PBIS is a research based system that leads to a positive school climate, increased attendance, increased positive behavior through incentives and interventions, and provides an avenue for social and emotional development.

May spring continue to bloom with many great ideas and the beginnings of wonderful opportunities to continue doing what we all love to do - support all of our students and watch them grow!

## Class Placement Information

We are beginning to plan for the next school year. In June we will begin the process of making up classes based upon our best estimate of the enrollment projections for next year. When making up classes, our goal is to create heterogeneous groupings of students as we scrutinize each child's educational needs. The major factors for consideration are: the child's demonstrated achievement in reading, math and other academic areas, the quality of the student's citizenship, his/her work and study habits, whether he/she requires guidance to behave and perform optimally, if he/she is a leader or follower, how he/she will fit in with the others in the class, and the boy-girl ratio in the class.

You can see this is a complicated process and is based upon our best assessment of each child. If you feel there is additional information you need to share, please pick up a room environment request form in the office (available beginning April 9th) and return it by Friday, May 3, 2019. Please do not request a specific teacher on your form, as these requests cannot be honored.

All parent requests are read and considered when placing students; the key ingredient in this process is trust. We, like you, want each child to have the best chance for success. Flory Academy is filled with hard-working, dedicated and talented teachers. Your child will be in good hands next year.

## Lice

Head lice are a nuisance but they are not associated with any disease. Current research shows that they are spread through prolonged head to head contact at home, during sleepovers and at campouts. MUSD aligns with the recommendations from major medical groups for the management of lice at school. Students found with live (crawling) lice will be sent home. Once the student has been treated, he/she can return to school after being checked by the school nurse. If a few nits (eggs) remain, the student can come back to class. The school staff will maintain the privacy of students identified as having head lice, and we ask that our parents do the same.
