



- Re-scheduled date confirmed for Thursday, June 1 from 6-8pm at PES
- Discussed permission slips:
  - Permission slip approved and copies in teacher mailboxes at PES by 5/15 to go home with students. Front office can email teachers to notify & request forms be sent home with students by ~5/17

  - Plan to have blank permission slips at the event for those who do not turn in (will serve to collect contact information / authorized pickups)

#### Fundraising and Spirit Nights, Jen Defendeifer

- The Fundraising Company (sneaker fundraiser)
  - 456 shoes collected as of today 244 shoes are still needed, but need to "round up" to ensure we have enough acceptable / usable shoes
  - o Will need volunteers to help pallet shoes for pickup when we have reached the goal
  - BIG push for shoes to come in before the end of the school year
    - Jenny to request Allyson post on FB and Ms. Lamm to send a school-wide e-mail on 5/9, specifically requesting families bring a shoe donation to Art & Music Night since a large crowd will be coming into the building

# **PES PTO Meeting Minutes**

- Color Run
  - o Thank you for all of the hard work in pulling off this amazing event !!
  - PES raised over \$5,600 (gross)! Jenny is coordinating with the Company for the final check with our profit portion.
  - Color Run Lead Volunteers from PES and PPS met for a post-event wrap-up to brainstorm ideas for next year and discuss if it makes sense to work with a Company to organize this event (as was done this year) or if it can be run by a committee of PTO volunteers so the PTOs can keep all proceeds. No final decision has been made.
    - Discussed suggestion to move the event to a Friday night in the Fall (will need to coordinate around football schedule). Elizabeth suggested a Sunday afternoon as a more ideal timeframe for consideration.
    - Consensus that the event needs to move out of the Spring to avoid following PES cookie dough fundraiser as well as overlapping with Spring sport fundraisers.
- Spirit Nights
  - Anna's Spirit Night made \$350 which was a huge success!
  - No additional Spirit Nights for 2022-2023 School Year

- Teacher Appreciation Week May 8th 12th
